## Summer Ball Program Policies

### General

- A Summer All-Star program will be available in Tadpole, Mosquito, Pee Wee, Bantam and Midget for players who played in those divisions in the regular season.
- Tadpole summer ball runs for the month of July playing every Tuesday & Thursday and ending with a tournament, hosted by Cloverdale, the last weekend of July.
- Mosquito A & AAA, Pee Wee A, AA & AAA, Bantam A and Midget AA will interlock with various other associations as determined by BC Minor Baseball. Schedules will vary and they can earn a spot in the B.C. Provincials in the month of August.
- Any Coach may apply for the position of Summer Ball Head Coach in his or her respective division. Seniority or standing in the league does not have any bearing on being picked for the position of Summer Ball Head Coach.
- The Coaches Selection Committee shall select the Summer Ball Head Coach in all divisions. Letters of intent to coach a Summer Ball team shall be made in writing from coaches to the CMBA Secretary by April 1st for Tadpole and Mosquito and April 30th for all other divisions. A copy of their current NCCP certificate must be submitted with their letter of intent.
- For the Summer Ball program, coaches must have the following requirements:
  - Mosquito A, AA, AAA – Head coach to have Regional Coach Trained status. All other coaches must be Initiation Coach Trained status.
  - Pee Wee A – Head coach to have Regional Coach Trained status. All other coaches must be Initiation Coach Trained status.
  - Pee Wee AA, AAA – Head coach to have Regional Coach Certified status. All other coaches must be Regional Coach Trained status.
  - Bantam A – Head coach to have Regional Coach Trained status. All other coaches must be Initiation Coach Trained status.
  - Bantam AA – Head coach to have Regional Coach Certified status. All other coaches must be Regional Coach Trained status.
  - Bantam AAA – Head coach to have Provincial Coach Certified status. All other coaches must be Provincial Coach Trained status.
  - Midget AA – Head coach to have Provincial Coach Certified status. All other coaches must be Provincial Coach Trained status.
  - Midget AAA – Head coach to have Provincial Coach Certified status. All other coaches must be Provincial Coach Trained status.
- Try-outs are open to all players in their division, however all Players must attend the try-outs for the Summer All-Star Program. Dates and times of tryouts will be posted on the Cloverdale Baseball web site.
- Players who play Pee Wee AA during the spring season will still need to try out to earn a spot on either the Pee Wee AAA or the Pee Wee AA summer ball team. They may be competing against Cloverdale Pee Wee A players vying for a roster spot on the same teams. However, no player from another association can displace a Cloverdale Pee Wee AA spring season player for a roster spot on one of the summer ball teams. Out of catchment players can only be considered eligible to fill vacant spots resulting from Cloverdale Pee Wee AA spring season players choosing to not to play summer ball, or by either of the teams electing to add an additional roster spot. If there is a vacant roster spot, an eligible out of catchment player may be added to either roster at the discretion of the coaches and approval of the board.
