



Norski Soccer Club (NSC) Financial Aid Application



NSC has established a program for which players/parents can *apply* to receive a financial aid for part of the player's fees. Financial aids are awarded based upon the financial needs of the applicant, availability of funds in the financial aid program and approval by the NSC Board of Directors based upon its established criteria. The program is open to all registered players/parents who meet the financial criteria, and are able to provide NSC Board of Directors with a complete and accurate application and supporting documentation.

** If your child receives REDUCED lunch, the registration fee is 50% of the total registration fee, including NSC coaching and tournament fees. A letter from your school stating you are on the reduced lunch program must be provided.

*** If your child is not on the free or reduced lunch program at their school and you are seeking a financial aid based on short term or extenuating financial hardship circumstances, please attach a written statement explaining the nature of the hardship along with 50% of the total registration fee, including NSC coaching and tournament fees.

ALL payments for fees must be sent in when applying for financial aid. If you checked the Free lunch box, please send in payment amount designated above. For Reduced lunch or Financial Hardship financial aids, please see your registration receipt to determine 50% of the total registration fee (including NSC coaching and Tournament fees) due for your child's age group. Please register prior to submitting application and include your registration receipt with all applications.

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1. Requests for financial aid must come from the player's parents or legal guardian. Players requesting financial aid must be playing U6(Micro Kickers) to U19 level soccer.
2. A separate form must be filled out and submitted for each player.
3. Eligibility is based upon the following criteria:
 - a. A player must have acceptance into his/her school's free or reduced lunch program.
 - b. No financial information is required, providing the player's parents/guardians submit a copy of a letter that confirms acceptance into the free or reduced lunch program at the player's school.
4. All other financial hardship requests must be submitted in writing to the NSC Board of Directors.
5. A player's family may receive financial aid for fall and spring season registrations. The player/parents are responsible for the non-refundable tryout fee deposit (if applicable). Any financial aid given is to be applied to the upcoming season registration, coaching and tournament fee total amount. Micro Kicker players need to apply for financial assistance each season (fall and spring) if applicable.
6. Applicants will receive acceptance or denial by written notification by NSC Board of Directors.
7. Acceptance into the NSC financial aid program does not guarantee full payment of a player's registration fees. The NSC has established a limited fund to assist players. Fee assistance award amounts will be based on the number of applicants and available funds.
8. The review policy for the NSC Board of Directors is as follows:
 - a. The NSC Board members will follow the guidelines outlined by the financial aid program.
 - b. The NSC Board members may not participate in a review or lobby for any player that is or could potentially be rostered on their team.
9. All financial aid requests will be held in the strictest of confidence by the NSC Board of Directors.
10. Financial aid awards must meet with the approval of the NSC Board of Directors. **NSC Board of Directors must receive all financial aid applications by July 15th for fall season and March 1st for spring season.** Any applications received after the deadline will be considered in the order in which they are received, and only if financial aid funds are available. Financial aid requests must be submitted prior to each soccer season (Fall & Spring), if applicable.
11. Financial aid recipients agree to the additional financial commitment of competitive traveling soccer (if applicable), including but not limited to, tryouts, tournaments, uniforms, and travel expenses.
12. Please complete all the registration information on the application on the previous page. If not completed, the financial aid form is not complete.
