(CLEVELAND) — Saint Ignatius High School student-athletes will participate in Spring Commitment Day on Tuesday, May 16 at 3 p.m. at The Breen Center for the Performing Arts at Saint Ignatius High School, located at 2008 West 30th, off Lorain Avenue and across from the main campus.
