- What we want to see at the end of the season?
 - To hear what a great season it was, kids developing into great team players, kids staying in hockey, smiling kids, happy parents, coaches and kids.
- What's going good with minor hockey and we need to keep doing it?
 - We have in real life registration, using technology for communication, good use of the website, we have a good number of volunteers, we have kids transferring into the organization, getting referees mentorship, registration number holding, collecting fees, we have a volunteer executive, ice is scheduled to be put in, we have sponsorship for new jerseys, tournaments are run well with minimal complaints, following the constitution, disciplinary committee dealt with issues, we have a good number of coaches for the younger kids.
- What's going not so good with minor hockey and we need to stop doing it?
 - Kids are needing to have fun, need better coaching oversight and better coach development and mentoring, there was late ice start last season, there is a lack of executive reporting, issues where there was only new (rookie) coaches coaching, need better communication when dealing with disciplinary issues, problems are ignored by volunteers, executive needs to be a team and support each other even if not all members agree on an issue.
- What are we not doing and we should start doing it?
 - Develop coach and manager package and support, have clear "rules" regarding tryouts, develop parent/registration package, enforcement of policies, use of technology for coaches, be hungrier for fundraising, executive should be expected to step up to cover areas where help is needed, hold development camps, ATM in arena, promoting and having a sponsor for the outdoor rink, figure out how to increase volunteers, develop plan to monitor dressing rooms, refresher on Respect in Sport, communication and definition of "bullying", discipline policy for parents, plan banquet earlier
