The Head Coach will lead our Saskatchewan team at the Alberta/Saskatchewan Challenge. The 2023 event will be held in Edmonton, July 10-14th, 2023. The event will be a 1 game 6-aside event between Saskatchewan and Alberta.

The Head Coach position requires a significant time commitment to scout and identify players, as well as coach Team Saskatchewan at the AB/SK Challenge. In addition, the Head Coach, with assistance of Football Saskatchewan staff, is responsible for selecting all assistant coaches.
