


Instructions for accepting SportsEngine Invite and Creating Account


1. You will receive an email from SportsEngine.com.

2. Click on the “Accept Invite” link in the email message.

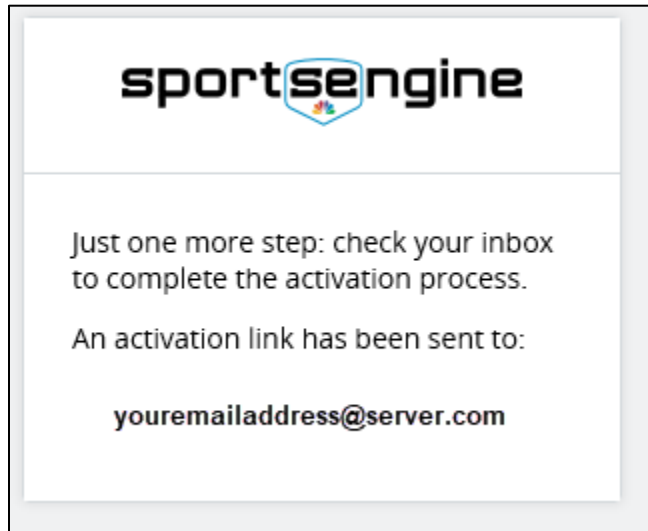

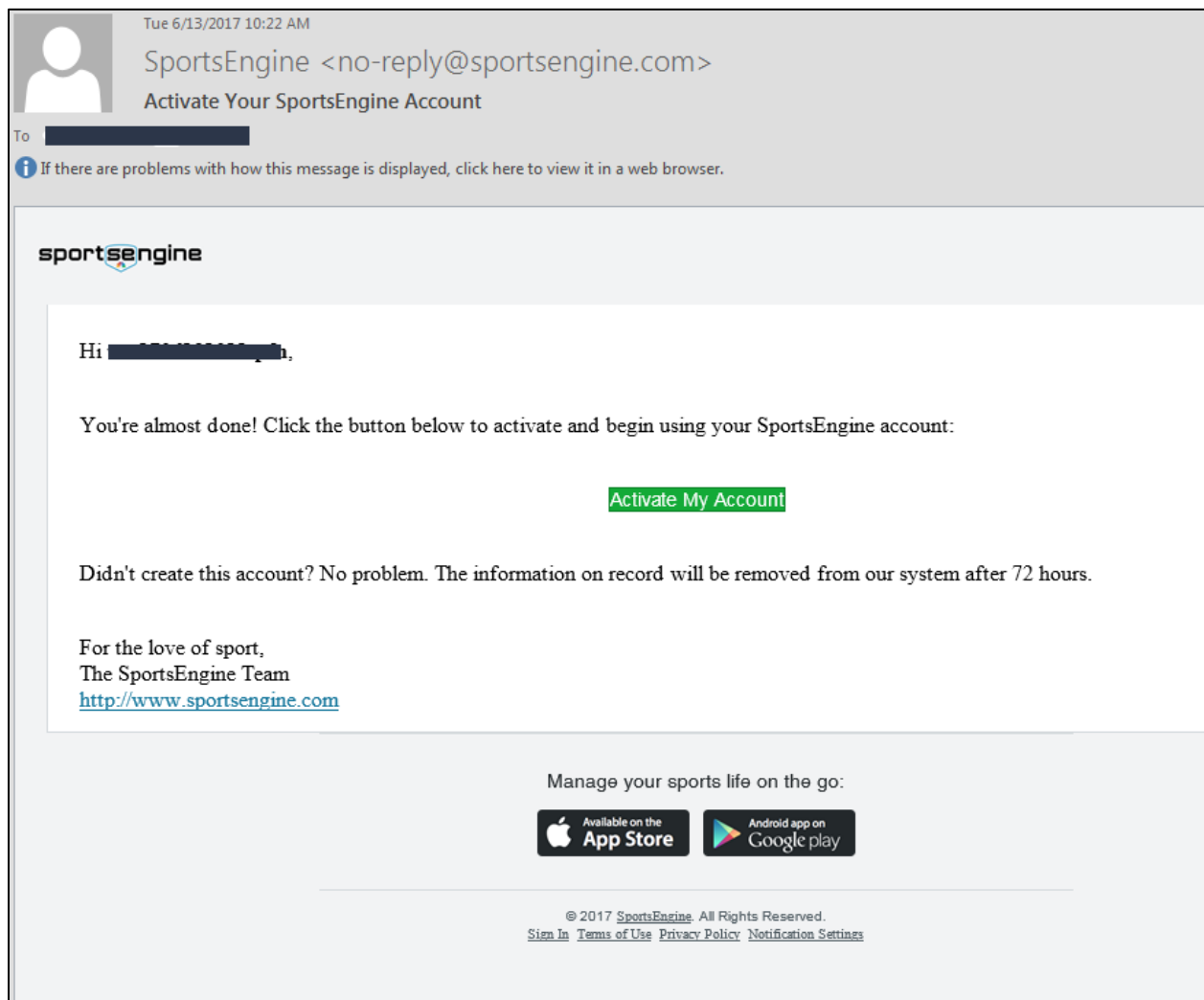

4. After filling in the form to create an account and clicking on the Create Account button. You will see a confirmation page telling you check your email.



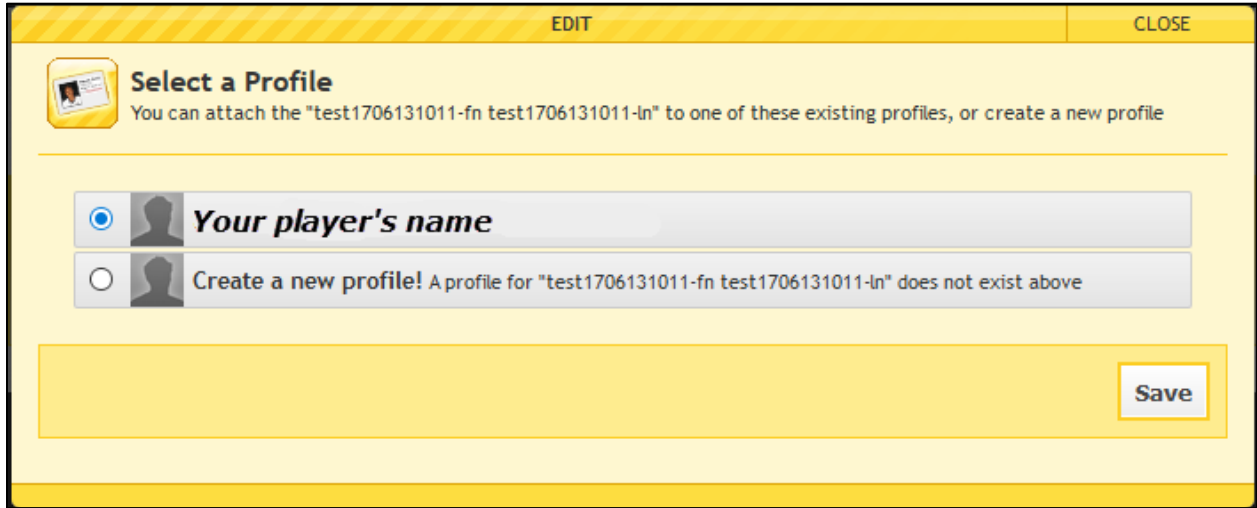
5. Check your email inbox for a confirmation email message from SportsEngine.com. Click on the “Activate My Account” link in the email
