



### **What to Bring with you to Camp?**

**Clothing:** Campers should bring plenty of clothing for all types of weather, T-shirts, sweatshirts, jeans, shorts, sweatpants, socks, underwear, swim suit, beach towel, and at least two pairs of tennis shoes. Sorry but there are no laundry facilities on site so bring plenty of clothing for hockey time, dry land training, lounging, and off site activities in and out of the water.

**Toiletries:** Campers will need toothpaste, tooth brush, washcloth, towels, deodorant and any other items they feel they need etc. Please send your camper with soap and shampoo. These items are not provided. Players are required to shower daily. Players should also pack sun screen and insect repellent. For younger players who are shy or new to showering in public shower facilities they are welcome to bring a swim suit to shower in and the showers do have privacy curtains between them.

**Bedding:** Campers need to bring sheets, blankets, pillows, and or sleeping bags. The dormitory is air conditioned but some sections do get colder or hotter than others so an extra blanket and a small fan may be helpful as well.

**Hockey Equipment:** Players are required to bring all of their protective hockey equipment including mouth pieces. Equipment is stored in the arena during the week in a dedicated locker room. Please bring an old stick for outdoor dry land shooting and training. We also have a pro shop on site in case you forget something like a mouth piece or tape etc. and we have on site skate sharpening for \$5.00.

**Non-Hockey Equipment:** Other equipment you may choose to bring with you to camp may include in-line skates, fishing pole, golf clubs if you plan to golf, tennis racquets, street hockey sticks, swimming trunks and towels.

**Resident Campers Lodging / Meals:** Resident campers receive 3 well rounded meals per day, any special needs or dietary considerations should be communicated to the camp administrator before your arrival at camp. Campers are allowed to bring their own snacks for the evenings as most get hungry before bed, the concession stand is open until 9:00pm each evening. Please do not send sunflower seeds, nuts, popcorn, or other messy snacks that will most likely get spilled in the rooms and attract ants etc. Most rooms sleep 4 campers with 2 bunks per room. We will do everything in our power to honor rooming together requests but we cannot always guarantee it.

**Spending Money / Camp Bank:** A camp bank will be available for players to keep their spending money in while at camp. All food, lodging, ice time, skills and dryland training, as well as in-house camp activities are included in the registration fees. The concession stand and pro shop will also be open during camp for purchases. We also offer some optional Vacationland Activities during the week that players will need additional money for if they choose to participate in them. We also have pool tables and ping pong tables in the dorms. Most players usually go through approximately \$100 in spending money depending on how many of the off-site activities they choose to participate in.

**Arena Concessions:** We operate a concession stand at the Arena that has drinks and snacks available for between meals and evening snacks. We have the following products available: Coke products, PowerAde, bottled water, slushies, hot dogs, pretzels, cookies, nachos, candy, chips, popcorn, and a variety of ice cream treats.

**Pro Shop:** The arena pro shop carries a complete line of equipment except for skates. The Pro Shop is open in the evenings for players to get skates sharpened or purchase other items they may need during the week. Skate sharpening is \$5.00.

**Camp Activities – No additional charge:** In Camp activities include swimming at the Resort Pools & Beaches, canoeing, fishing, and tennis at the Resort, volleyball at the beach and at the dorms, soccer, ping pong, knee hockey, movies, basketball, horseshoes, and ladder golf at the dorms.
