- ✓ Help establish selection criteria and host tryouts.

Must be completed by Head Coaches once a team is assigned:

- √ Notify and gain commitment from selected players and parents through phone calls
- ✓ Ensure all players are of league age requirements
- ✓ Ensure communication with parents regarding practices, games, player medical conditions, etc.
- ✓ All Player forms and Parent Code of Conduct forms are filled out and filed with Power Alley Baseball in a timely manner
- ✓ Coach's Code of Conduct form filled out and filed with Power Alley Baseball
- ✓ Ensure Background Checks are done on all coaches assigned to the team through Power Alley Baseball and the LBA
- ✓ Ensure Concussion Training is done and certification turned in to The Power Alley Baseball board
- ✓ Provide updates to the Power Alley Baseball board as needed
