There is entertainment for everyone and brings people from all over to enjoy the Rocky Mountains. Enjoy strolling down Meadow Drive while tasting treats from Colorado.

Minturn Market—June 17 thru Sept 9. Located in charming Minturn, the market features over 85 vendors with items from great breakfast and lunch to gourmet foods, gifts, clothing, jewelry, handmade crafts, items for the home, fine art and more. Face painting for the kids and live music.

Free Things To Do

New this summer—all kids can ride the Vail Mountain gondola free with the purchase of an adult ticket, allowing children 12 and under to experience panoramic views of the Vail Valley and the surrounding mountains.

Betty Ford Alpine Gardens—Enjoy the highest botanical gardens in the world with a unique collection of alpine, sub-alpine and other mountain plants and flowers. Open daily from dawn to dusk.

Go for a run with the Vail Rec District— Residents and visitors are encouraged to join this weekly running club that will lead participants around Vail's scenic recreation paths and scenic trails. The club will be led by local runner Greg Decent and will meet on Thursdays at 5:30 PM starting June 23 at the base of the Vista Bahn in Vail Village.

Please Note! For guests arriving through the middle of November from the West, we recommend that you continue on I-70 to the main Vail Exit 176. Access the Resort from the North Frontage Road at Exit 176 due to the North Frontage Road one way traffic limitation for the Vail Underpass construction. Project will be completed by the start of the 2017/18 ski season and will provide us all with better access to both Vail Village and Lionshead.



Vail Run Resort Information

The front desk is open from 7:15 AM to 10:45 PM daily. If you are going to arrive after 10:30 PM, you must contact the front desk in advance for check in instructions and to make arrangements for a late check in.

It is required that all owners, guests, exchange guests and renters have the correct parking pass in their vehicle and are parking in the appropriate lot.
