DEAL SOFTBALL LEAGUE RULES AND REGULATIONS

EVERY PLAYER FROM ROOKIE TO ALL-STAR MUST ABIDE BY THESE RULES

I. STARTING GAMES:

- A) Games must start at 10:00 AM and 1:00 PM sharp. A Forfeit will be declared if a team is not ready to play by 10:15 AM or 1:15 PM.
- B) If there is a forfeit in the first game of the doubleheader, the starting time of the following game is 11:00 AM OR 2:00 PM.
- C) There will be a 10 minute break between games.
- D) Games must start once 9 players are present. There will not be a delay to wait for a specific player to arrive.
- E) 9 players can be used if 10 players are not available. There is no penalty of an out in the 10th batting slot.
- F) 8 players can also be used if 10 players are not available. This team can borrow a person to catch from opposing team, or any other team, but the catcher can not bat, and there will be an automatic out in the 9th batting slot.

II. PLAYING TIME:

- A) Each player from every team must play a minimum of 3 innings or 2 at bats per doubleheader.

III. COIN TOSS:

- A) The team that wins the coin toss has the choice of picking which game of the doubleheader they will bat first or last.

EXAMPLE: If Team X wins the coin toss, they can choose to bat last in the second game of the doubleheader. Team Y will have its choice in the first game.

IV. SCHEDULE CHANGES

- A) There will be no switching of times, fields, or opponents by any team. The schedule must be followed strictly.
- B) In case of rain out, that game will be played at end of season (NOT THE FOLLOWING WEEK).
- C) If game is interrupted by rain or anything else, that game will be continued exactly where it left off at a later date. (The same team rosters and line-ups will be used unless there was an injury replacement or a trade in the interim).

DEAL SOFTBALL LEAGUE RULES AND REGULATIONS

V. PINCH RUNNING

- A) If a player is injured and unable to run, the opposing team can select anyone on that team to pinch run.
- B) Pitchers are not obligated to run. The opposing team can select anyone on that team to pinch run for the pitcher.
- C) In regard to rules A and B, (above), those people selected to pinch run can still play in another slot.

VI. SUBSTITUTIONS

- A) Players are interchangeable within the same slot. If the subs are not reported to the scoreboard umpire, and opposing team, it will be an automatic out.

VII. SLIDING

- A) It is mandatory that players slide into bases if the play is close. Any collisions will result in an automatic out and that player will be ejected from that game.

VIII. DISPUTING A CALL

- A) Any argument over a call must be handled by the acting captain only! Any other players will be ejected for that game. (If the umpire feels another game suspension is in order, that player will be suspended for the next game as well.).
- B) NO ONE can touch an umpire! Not even in a friendly manner! Any one doing so will be ejected for at least one game.
- C) Any fighting during the games will result in an automatic ejection for the remainder of that game and for the following 2 games! (All participants are included). Any repeat offenders will be expelled from the league and his team can not replace him!

IX. TRADING PLAYERS

- A) The trading deadline is Friday before the 9th game of the season.
- B) All trades must be reported to a committee member (Ed Beda, Steve Shalom, Ike Dweck, Jack Braha, Ed Mishan, or Freddie Harari). All teams involved with the trade must report it. (If only one team reports it, it is not an official trade).
- C) If the committee decides the trade is unbalanced it can veto the trade for the good of the league.

DEAL SOFTBALL LEAGUE RULES AND REGULATIONS

X. PLAYER REPLACEMENT

- A) During the regular season if a player can not play anymore, that team can replace him.
- B) Once a player is replaced, that player can not re-enter the league for that season.
- C) The committee will decide if the replacement is fair.

EXAMPLE: If Team X loses a player that was selected in the 5th round, they can only choose a player with a 5th round or higher ranking.

- D) Same rules apply during post season and world series.
- E) Committee can veto any replacement if they think it is unjust.

XI. PLAY-OFF RULES

- A) The top six teams make the playoffs.
- B) The first place team and the second place team draw a BYE in the first round.
- C) The first round of the playoffs will be a best two out of three game series.
- D) The second round of the playoffs will be a best three out of five series.
- E) The World Series will be a best three out of five series.
- F) Throughout the playoffs and the world series the team with the better record gets their choice to bat first in the odd games (games #1, #3, #5).
- G) Tie breaking Procedures
 1. If there is a tie between 2 teams in head to head competition, and these teams split during the regular season then it goes to a coin toss.
 2. However, if its a tie for a BYE or a tie for the last playoff spot (where a team can be eliminated from making the playoffs) then instead of a coin toss a 5 inning game will determine the winner.
 3. This 5 inning games is played only if the teams split during the season.
 4. Following the 5 inning tie breaking game the first round doubleheader of the playoffs will start. There will be 2 games played each day in all the playoff rounds.
 5. In case of a 3 way tie, the team or teams with the best combined record against each other wins the tie.

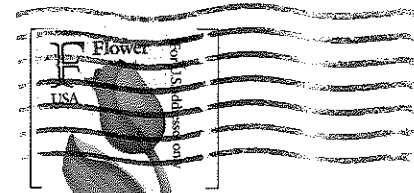
XI) Play-Off Rules- (continued from Page 5)

H) Play-off Schedule

Round 1: The third place team plays the sixth place team at 10:00 AM on Field - C.
The fourth place team plays the fifth place team at 4:00PM on Field C.

Week 2: If round one needs a rubber game it will be played at 10:00AM. The second round will begin 1/2 hour after round one is finished. Only one game will be played in the second round if the first round playoff series needs a rubber game. If round one results in a sweep, the second round will start at 10:00 AM with a double header.

Round 2: The first place team plays the team with the worst record at 10:00 AM on Field (Double Header).
The second place team plays the remaining team at 4:00 PM on Field (Double Header).
