

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

I WILL:

- 1. Behave appropriately at practices and games/tournaments and will respect the volunteers and property of the game/tournament site and understand I represent RAYBA.
- 2. Not swear or disrupt practices and games/tournaments by arguing or harassing fans, other teams or officials.
- 3. Play a physical and aggressive game, but not dirty.
- Support and Respect my Teammates, Coach and Parents. I understand that jealousy, backstabbing and gossip about teammates and coaches will be unacceptable.
- 5. Encourage good sportsmanship and not trash talk fans, referees or other opponents.
- 6. Maintain passing grades.
- 7. Be on time for practice and games/tournaments and will give 100% during practices and games/tournaments. Practice is to learn not socialize.
- 8. Read and abide by the rules set forth by RAYBA.
- 9. Communicate my concerns through the proper channels in a dignified manner as defined in the grievance procedures.

Consequences of Non-Compliance to the Player Code of Conduct:

1. If a player does not or will not comply with the guidelines of the above stated code of conduct or team rules specified by the head coach, the head coach may:

- A. Bench the player
- B. Reduce playing-time
- 2. In the event a player is deemed to continue not to be in compliance with this code of conduct, the following will occur:

(over)

1st offense: Verbal Warning by the Board

2nd offense: Written Warning and 1 Weekend's Suspension by the

Board

<u>3rd offense</u>: Incident will be reviewed by the RAYBA Board with a suspension and possible dismissal from the program for the player.

3. Ejection from any game will result in an immediate review of the incident with the Coach, Referees and Player by the House Director or Travel Director and may result in the suspension from the next weeks game(s)/Tournament (Travel).

Any person ejected from a game will be suspended a minimum of 1 game. The RAYBA board will make a final determination on the length of the suspension. Any person ejected, may appeal the suspension with the RAYBA board.

Every violation of the code of conduct is subject to review by RAYBA Board Members. The board will determine final action based on the review.
