Player Code of Conduct

Saratoga-Wilton Youth Baseball has implemented the following Player Code of Conduct.

1. I will show respect to all coaches, umpires, parents, teammates, and opposing players at all times, and will never act in a manner that is disrespectful to them or my team.
2. I will demonstrate good sportsmanship regardless of the score or situation by acting in a positive manner towards coaches, umpires, and other players.
3. I will help clean the team bench after games and keep the field clean during practices.
4. I will shake hands with the other team and umpires after games.

Ejections and Suspensions

If a player gets ejected from a game they must leave the facility. They will not be permitted to attend the next game on the schedule, nor will they be allowed to attend games during the suspension. If a player is ejected from 2 games during a season, they will be suspended indefinitely.

The Board of Directors has exclusive authority over the duration of suspensions according to the severity of the infraction. The Board of Directors reserves the right to review the eligibility standing moving forward for any player previously suspended under this policy.
