### Wildcats Storylines ...

BO AND BOBO KNOW FOOTBALL: A major strength of the Saint Ignatius offense is the one-two punch of senior Mark Bobinski "Bobo" and junior Jahadge "Bo" Floyd. Bobinski served as the lead back last season, racking up over 1,000 yards last season, and hopes to do the same in 2017. Bobinski has 139 yards and 1 touchdown through two games against tough teams. Floyd enjoyed a coming out party against Mentor, gashing the Cardinals for 114 yards and a touchdown on 22 carries. The two will be a dangerous duo against Euclid.

JOY-STICK: Senior Logan Joyce is developing a reputation as a monster on the gridiron. The Bay native has thrilled fans in the first weeks of the season with his brute force and hitstick tackles. Joyce notched 5 tackles, 2.5 tackles for loss, and quarterback hurry against Mentor, proving himself as a major factor against both the running game and the passing game. Only Tommy Eichenberg has matched Joyce's figure of 4 tackles for loss on the season.

HALL HEROIC: Senior quarterback Kyle Hall thrived in his second start under center for the Wildcats on Friday. Hall finished 14-of-30 for 291 yards and 3 touchdowns, not quite perfect but not far from it. The senior found Sammy "The Ringmaster" Snyder six times for 115 yards and two scores against the Cardinals, also slinging it four times for 82 yards and a touchdown to Michael Drobnick. As Hall said after the game, his offensive line and running backs provided plenty of help.

NO FLY ZONE: The efforts of the Saint Ignatius secondary have not gone unnoticed. The Wildcats held Mentor's potent offense to 31 points, including two crucial interceptions. Cameron Toppin notched his third interception in two weeks, and Danny Scelza picked off the Cards at the end of the second quarter, setting up a Wildcats' touchdown. Justin Sands has played a large role at safety, as has Mitch Puhalsky. Junior Jett Elad has proven himself at the varsity level, too, serving as a trusty corner in man coverage. Elad, younger brother of Stan Elad II, broke up five passes last week.

KICK IT, TRICKETT!: Senior Matthew Trickett continues to lead the way for the Wildcats on special teams. Trickett connected on two field goals, notched 4 touchbacks, and 4 punts for a 37.5 yard average against Mentor. In his spare time, Trickett, along with his fellow special teamers, will be raising money for cancer research through Kick-It for Cancer.

**STUD SOPHOMORE, PART II:** For the second straight week, sophomore Connor Cmiel wowed JV Cats fans. Cmiel returned back-to-back kick returns for touchdowns, giving him three on the season. Unfortunately, the JV Cats fell as a team to Mentor, as did the Freshmen Football Cats.

## **ABOUT THE PANTHERS ...**

### Learning about the Panthers ...

THE LONG-AWAITED REMATCH: The Panthers are quite familiar with the Wildcats, however it's been some time since the private-public school rivals have faced off on the gridiron. Euclid and Saint Ignatius last battled in 1999, an OHSAA Regional Semifinal contest. The Wildcats won, 28-14, en route to an OHSAA Division I State Championship. Euclid will look to end Saint Ignatius' long winning streak over the Panthers at 11 games.

A "WARRIOR" UNDER CENTER: The master of the Euclid offense is Cee Jay Hale. The multitalented quarterback can do the trick with his arm and his legs, leading head coach Jeff Rotsky to call him a "warrior" after the team's opening win over Glenville. Hale scored three touchdowns against The Ville, helping the Panthers roar to a 26-0 start in the first quarter. Hale helped the Panthers open a 27-7 lead against Aurora, too, finishing with 230 passing yards and four touchdowns.

GO LONG, DRE'VON: Hale's success on offense against Aurora was supplemented by his new star wideout, Dre'Von Lindsay. The Garfield Heights transfer tabbed 189 receiving yards and three touchdowns against the Greenmen last week. Lindsay will look to test the Wildcats in both the short and deep passing game. Lindsay opened the Aurora game by catching a slant pass from Hale and scooting 80 yards for a score.

**SPEED IN THE SECONDARY:** Jeff Rotsky's defense prides itself on its speed. The Panthers have plenty of athletes in the secondary, foremost among them Arquon Bush. A University of Cincinnati recruit, Bush will play a large role in opposing Kyle Hall and the Wildcats' passing attack. Rotsky and his secondary will likely play plenty of man coverage, looking to limit the Wildcats' shifty receivers.

**STRONG UP FRONT:** The Euclid defense has played strong and aggressively against its first two opponents, showing a propensity to move strongly to the ball on running plays. The Panthers will likely utilize a six-man front, or a version of the 4-2-5 defense, though occasionally rotating between three and four down linemen. Euclid's ability to hold off the Wildcats' two-pronged rushing attack will be something to watch.

LOOK OUT FOR LEE: Running back Ronald Lee will be an X-factor for Euclid on Saturday. The senior accounted for 144 yards on 12 carries against Aurora and two touchdowns against Glenville. Lee will need to succeed on the ground to provide balance for Hale.

## **EDDIE DWYER'S PREVIEW**

#### By Eddie Dwyer

OHIO CITY - While the current players from Saint Ignatius and Euclid were just infants or not even born when the Wildcats and the Panthers last met on the Varsity gridiron, a 28-14, first-round playoff victory by Saint Ignatius in 1999, they have heard the stories that stemmed from two of the most memorable encounters in a series that Saint Ignatius leads, 11-1.

After then sophomore tailback Robert Smith led Euclid to a 30-7 victory over the Wildcats in Week 2 of the 1987 regular season, Saint Ignatius began its 11-0 run over the Panthers with regular season and postseason triumphs in 1988.

Smith, an area high school legend as a perennial All-Scholastic, All-State and All-American performer, a two-time Ohio Mr. Football (1988 and 1989) and the Bobby Dodd National Back of the Year, went on to excel in football and track at The Ohio State University and was an NFL All-Pro tailback for the Minnesota Vikings. Robert is currently an outstanding College Football Analyst for Fox News and The Big 10 Network.

With Smith back for his senior year at Euclid and Saint Ignatius riding the momentum of its first of what are now a record 11 OHSAA Division I State Football Championships, the two most memorable or storied encounters with Euclid both took place in the season of 1989.

First it was the media frenzy that surrounded the 1989 regular season game, a matchup of two of the most celebrated players not only in Ohio, but the entire nation - Smith and Wildcats All-American senior quarterback Joe Pickens.

Played on a warm September night in Lakewood Stadium, the game had the added hype of being the first nationally televised regular season high school football game. SportsChannel America did the honors.

During the week leading up to the game, coaches and players from Saint Ignatius and Euclid had to attend press conferences in order to build up the national hoopla.

Behind an outstanding performance by senior two-way tackle Trent Zenkewicz, who was one of the most dominant defensive players in the history of Ohio high school football, and memorable efforts by senior defensive back/wide receiver Mark Ruddy and senior linebacker Ryan Spicer, the Wildcats went on to dominate the Panthers, 55-26, in front of a packed Lakewood Stadium and a national television audience. Ruddy's play on both sides of the ball earned him Plain Dealer Player of the Week honors.

The second meeting between Saint Ignatius and Euclid in 1989 had much more at stake and was a different game, to say the least, than the ballyhooed regular season matchup.

In what is still one of the most memorable games in the history of the OHSAA playoffs, the Wildcats trailed the Panthers by 11 points with 10 minutes and 1 second remaining in the Division I Regional Final at Baldwin-Wallace College's Finnie Stadium (now Baldwin Wallace University).

Saint Ignatius, behind an 85-yard kickoff return for a touchdown by gifted senior running back/linebacker Tim Kennedy, a remarkable 30-yard reception by tough and talented senior tight end John Jaeckin, a 7-yard touchdown run by standout senior tailback Pete Fitzpatrick and a game-clinching interception by ever-present senior safety/wide receiver Patrick Friend with 42 seconds remaining to be played, pulled off the amazing comeback, 31-30. The Wildcats prevailed despite failing to convert on either of their two-point conversion attempts following the Kennedy and Fitzpatrick touchdowns.

Jaeckin's diving catch, which came off a third-and-long from deep in Wildcats territory, saw John haul in a desperation pass from Pickens that deflected off the hands of one defender and bounced off the helmet and pads of another Panther. Coach Tom Banc's Euclid Panthers, who utilized Robert Smith as both a tailback and a quarterback versus Saint Ignatius, lost only four games over the 1988 and 1989 seasons, all four of them to Saint Ignatius. That, and the fact that the Wildcats lead the all-time series, 11-1, is why Coach Banc, retired now after a brilliant career, would always tell this reporter with a smile that he should be in the Saint Ignatius Hall of Fame.

Ok, that's this old gridiron grinder's drive down the memory lane of what was and will become again on Saturday night, Euclid versus Saint Ignatius in area high school football.

Now it is my privilege to give you comments from the man who orchestrated those memorable 1989 nights at Lakewood Stadium and Finnie Stadium, along with the Wildcats' record 11 Division I state championships (including a remarkable five in a row, 1991-1995), two state runner-

up finishes (1996 and 2016), three national titles (1989, 1993 and 1995) and a national runner-up in 2008, Hall of Fame Head Coach Mr. Chuck Kyle '69.

FROM COACH KYLE: "Euclid was a really awesome football team, they were great," Coach Kyle said as he was putting his Wildcats through their Tuesday afternoon practice. "You really had to come up with a Robert Smith defense, because we had to try to box him in. Once he got a seam, it was over.

"That was a classic, in all phases of the game," Coach Kyle continued in reference to the 1989 regional final versus Euclid. "Tom (Coach Banc) was a great coach. We always got along real well. To have a coaching camaraderie, you have to have fun."

COACH KYLE ON THE 2017 EUCLID PANTHERS OF HEAD COACH JEFF ROTSKY: "Euclid is playing good football," said Coach Kyle of Saturday's Home Opener at Byers Field, a renewal that will match the area's top-ranked Wildcats (2-0) and eleventh-ranked Panthers (2-0). "They're used to making the playoffs and they expect to make the playoffs. They have that whole view happening now. I don't see any concern on their part of what has happened in the past (the Wildcats' 11-0 run versus Euclid).

"Offensively, they have some very skilled players," Coach Kyle said. "Their quarterback, Cee Jay Hale, they will drop him back and he will hit the hitches, the fades and the slants for big plays. But also, when he tucks the ball down, he's a weapon. He makes some nice cuts and picks up some key yardage when there is nothing open in the passing game."

Cee Jay Hale, displaying his arm and his legs, led the Panthers to a 39-21, opening-weekend victory over Glenville at Collinwood Railroaders Stadium. With Hale showing the way, Euclid jumped out to a 26-0 lead in the game's first nine minutes.

Coach Rotsky, who is 19-7 in his third season with the Panthers, described Hale as a "warrior" after the Glenville game.

Last weekend, Euclid defeated Aurora, 27-21, as junior Dre'Von Lindsay hauled in thee touchdown passes from Hale. That was an impressive victory when you consider that Aurora defeated the Panthers, 41-13, in 2016.

Despite graduating a strong senior class from 2016, the Panthers earned the respect of the outstanding high school staff at The News-Herald by being ranked No. 1 in The News Herald's storied poll known as "The Top of the Crop." Helping Euclid earn that honor is one of the premier players in the area, senior wide receiver, cornerback and kick returner Arquon Bush, a University of Cincinnati recruit by Head Coach Luke Fickell.

"Defensively, their line really gets off the ball," said Coach Kyle. "They just really take the gaps hard and their secondary is going to come up and press. So it will be another good test for our offensive line, which so far has done really well with the challenges they have faced (Archbishop Hoban and Mentor)."

Coach Kyle also paid his compliments to the Panthers' Bush, saying that the young man really plays hard never leaves the field, which, added Coach Kyle, is a credit to him for doing everything he can to help his team.

Please note that Saint Ignatius' Junior Varsity Game versus the Panthers has been switched to Monday, Sept. 11 at Euclid. It was originally scheduled for Saturday morning.

A CASE FOR THE DEFENSE: Through Week 2, Wildcats relentless junior linebacker Tommy Eichenberg has been involved in 19 tackles, including 4 for -minus 19 yards. Standout senior cornerback Cam Toppin has 12 tackles and three interceptions; senior linebacker Logan Joyce has been in on 12 tackles, including 4 for -minus 12 yards; strong and savvy senior safety/Captain Justin Sands, a Penn recruit, has eight tackles and an interception; senior nose tackle/fullback Aidan Gill, the pride of Our Lady of Angels, has recorded 2.5 sacks for -minus 17 yards; multi-skilled junior cornerback Jett Elad has seven unassisted tackles and hard nosed junior safety Danny Scelza came up with a momentum-swinging interception return of 26 yards in last week's 41-31 victory at Mentor.

OFFENSIVE PRODUCTION: The powerful leg of senior kicker Matthew Trickett has produced 16 points on 3 field goals and 7 extra-point kicks; senior tailback/Captain Mark Bobinski has rushed for 139 yards and a touchdown on 48 carries; junior tailback Jahadge "Bo" Floyd has rushed for 114 yards and a touchdown on 22 carries; senior quarterback Kyle Hall is 29-of-55 through the air for 504 yards and four touchdowns, and one of the best 1-2 receiving punches in Northeast Ohio shows senior Sammy Snyder with 12 receptions for 227 yards and two touchdowns and senior Michael Drobnick with 7 receptions for 122 yards and a touchdown.

## **MENTOR RECAP**

MENTOR - Wearing a smile brighter than the Friday night lights on Center Street in Mentor, Saint Ignatius' strong and gifted junior tailback Jahadge "Bo" Floyd talked about the biggest game to date in his young, but oh so promising Varsity Football career.

"I got my sea legs, my first carry ever on Varsity," said Jahadge after he helped the area's top-ranked Wildcats improve to 2-0 with a take-control-down-the-stretch, 41-31 triumph over the fifth-tanked Mentor Cardinals (1-1) at a packed Jerome T. Osborne Sr. Stadium.

While Jahadge will always remember his first carry for the tradition-rich varsity football program at Saint Ignatius, which took place during one of the premier rivalries in Ohio high school football, his smile will grow even wider when he sees the final numbers he put up in a game that was still in doubt with just over four minutes remaining in the fourth quarter.

"A first I was kind of hesitant, I wasn't really 100 percent sure of myself," Jahadge shared with this corner just seconds after the Wildcats saluted their great Student Body support and sang the Alma Mater.

"At halftime, the coaches told me, alright, you got your first couple of reps in, it's time to do 'Bo' now."

And what "Bo" and his teammates did had the Wildcats' faithful roaring with approval down the stretch of the second half.

On the strength of touchdown passes of 28 yards and 12 yards from gritty senior quarterback Kyle Hall to his outstanding senior receivers Sammy Snyder and Michael Drobnick, and the ensuing extra-point kicks by senior Matthew Trickett, Saint Ignatius led, 24-10, at halftime.

Mentor, which lost for the 13th time in what was the 21st chapter of the storied and classy Public School versus Catholic School encounter, came storming back in the third quarter behind its savvy, skilled and big-game tested senior quarterback Tadas Tatarunas.

The 6-foot-5, 220-pound Tatarunas would score on a 5-yard run up the gut and then he hooked up with sophomore wide receiver Luke Floriea on a 17-yard TD pass that, after junior Conor McIntosh's extra-point kick, knotted the score at 24 with 6 minutes and 32 seconds left in the third quarter.

Saint Ignatius, responding in a manner one would associate with a record 11-time OHSAA Division I state champion and a three-time national champ, regained the lead when Hall saw Snyder breaking free in the left corner of the open end zone of Jerome T. Osborne Sr. Stadium and let loose with a pass that sure-handed Sammy brought down for a touchdown as time expired in the third quarter. Trickett's PAT was high and true, and the Wildcats led, 31-24.

"It was just a great job by the O-Line versus their D-Line and Kyle put the ball up and allowed me to make a play on it," said Snyder. "We've been doing this since mini camps and two-a-days, it's almost secondary for us. That is why you play football, for those type of plays. Once again, I thank Kyle."

Sammy revealed that he played running back until he entered high school and he credits his friend growing up, Brian Carney, for helping him develop his receiving skills. Carney, said Sammy, always threw long passes that Sammy, as a halfback, came out of the backfield and caught.

Following Sammy's second TD on the night, it was "Bo" time, as Jahadge, unleashing his balance, strength and vision, took full advantage of another strong night by an offensive line that is under the tutelage of veteran coaches Adam Rini '99 and Paul Yappel.

Undaunted by a flag that wiped out his 8-yard touchdown run, Jahadge, just a few plays later, would power his way for a 10-yard scoring run. As far as those final numbers we referred to earlier, the "Bo" show produced 114 yards on 22 carries. Jahadge also had a combined reception and run of 29 yards.

"In the third and fourth quarter I went 'Bo,' I got used to it," said Jahadge. "The offensive line is great, they are the reason I did so well."

More ball-control work by Jahadge and the O-Line led to a 42 yard field goal by Trickett that increased the Wildcats' lead to 41-24, and Saint Ignatius withstood a 46-yard touchdown pass from Tatarunas to senior wide receiver Steven Baird with 4:21 let on the clock

THE EARLY GOING: Saint Ignatius took a 3-0 lead in the first quarter behind a 32-yard field goal by Trickett and led, 10-0, after standout senior tailback and captain Mark Bobinski scored off a 2-yard run with 8:10 to go in the second quarter. Trickett was the ticket on the extra point.

Mentor would tie the score at 10 on a 22-yard field goal by Mc-Intosh, a 13-yard touchdown pass from Tatarunas to senior wide receiver Logan Shea and the PAT by McIntosh.

A NEW NICKNAME FOR SURE-HANDED SAMMY: "He's The Ring Master, he makes all the circus catches," said Wildcats assistant defensive line coach and Head Wrestling Coach Mark Sullivan of Sammy Snyder.

BY THE NUMBERS: Along with Jahadge "Bo" Floyd's big night on the ground, "The Ring Master," aka Sammy Snyder, had six receptions for 115 yards to go along with his two TD catches and Michael Drobnick, one of Coach Sullivan's wrestling mainstays, had 82 yards and a touchdown on four receptions. Bobinski rushed for 97 yards and a score on 23 carries.

Tatarunas was 25-of-43 through the air for 341 yards and three touchdown passes. Kyle Hall was 14-of-30 for 291 yards and three touchdown strikes.

Saint Ignatius led in first downs, 24-18, rushing yards, 227 to 70, and total offense, 518 yards to 411 for Mentor.

A CASE FOR THE DEFENSE: Ever-present junior cornerback Danny Scelza came up with a key momentum-swinging interception of Tatarunas. Senior defensive back Cam Toppin turned in another solid performance that included his third interception on the young season and six unassisted tackles. Cam also returned four kickoffs for a total of 57 yards.

Tough and talented junior linebacker Tommy Eichenberg made seven tackles, including a key sack, and this old gridiron grinder was impressed with the pressure off the edge applied by senior linebacker Logan Joyce.

FROM SAINT IGNATIUS' HALL OF FAME HEAD COACH CHUCK KYLE '69: "They're not the biggest guys to ever wear a Saint Ignatius uniform," Coach Kyle said of the 5-foot-9,155-pound Sammy Snyder and the 5-9, 160-pound Jahadge "Bo" Floyd. "Sammy was getting one-on-one coverage and we just feel he's a hard guy to cover one-on-one. We just had faith he would do his thing.

"He gave us a spark and was just finding the seams," Coach Kyle continued in reference to Jahadge "Bo" Floyd's Varsity coming out party. "He's got great vision and he has a little spurt to him. When he sees that seam, the next 7 or 8 yards he's home. He kind of took over the last part of the game. To have Mark Bobinski and Jahadge, that's huge."

Coach Kyle, who will lead his Wildcats against the 2-0 Euclid Panthers in next Saturday's (Sept. 9) 7 PM home opener at Byers Field in Parma's Robert M. Boulton Stadium, also praised the 'Cats' offensive line for adjusting nicely to Mentor's various blitz packages.

Have a wonderful Labor Day Weekend and we will see you at Wasmer Field later this morning (Saturday) for the 10 AM Junior Varsity encounter between the JV Wildcats and the Mentor Cardinals' Jayvees. As always, this old gridiron grinder will preview early next week what is one of the finest Catholic School versus Public School rivalries in the nation.

## BYERS FIELD at Richard M. Boulton Stadium



7600 Day Drive (corner of Ridge Road and Day Drive) Parma, Ohio

Seating Capacity: 11,850 Playing Surface: Field Turf Built: 1928 (Major Renovations in 1940, 1957, 1963, 1993, 2013)

2017 marks the 90th season that football has been played on this location; now known as Byers Field at Robert M. Boulton Stadium.

In 1921, the cities of Parma and Parma Heights opened the first high school for their residents on a site just outside the east bleachers. Seven years later, the apple orchard and grass field located behind the new school was converted into the athletic field with the gridiron laid out in a north-south alignment, just as it is today.

Recently, renovations have been completed on the facility.

In the last decade, a new lighting system was installed; bleacher improvements (including the installation of handrails) were completed along with renovations to the lockerrooms, restrooms and concession areas.

Other improvements include the installation of a video board at the north end of the stadium - it is one of the largest video boards in use at a high school facility the state.

The pressbox, which has been upgraded in the past five seasons with a new working media area and new windows, seats 30 journalists and broadcasters.

New field turf was installed for the 2012 season. In the last two seasons, the stadium has also had handicap seating added to both sets of grandstands, including 46 wheelchair and companion seats on the home side of the stadium.

The Parma City Schools invested nearly \$1.2 million into the facilty during the summer of 2014, including a new parking lot on the south end of the Stadium and the full replacement of the parking lot on the east side of the stadium, under the Press Box.

## #58MILESTOCANTON



On September 17, 1920, seven men, including the legendary Jim Thorpe met in Canton, Ohio to form the American Professional Football Association (APFA), a precursor to today's National Football League.

An early hotbed of football, Canton was selected as the site of the Pro Football Hall of Fame, which opened its doors on September 7, 1963.

Before the Hall of Fame came into existence, Fawcett Stadium was erected in 1938. The facility housed the successful McKinley Bulldogs.

After the Hall of Fame was built in Fawcett's backyard, the stadium hosted the Hall of Fame Game beginning in 1962. The first two Hall of Fame enshrinements took place in Fawcett Stadium, too.

For a period of time in the 1990's and 2000's, Fawcett Stadium hosted the OHSAA's Division I State Championship games. Saint Ignatius football fans became well-acquainted during this time, as the Wildcats played six state title games at Fawcett Stadium.

The Wildcats' third state title in 1991 was played at Fawcett, as the Football Cats defeated Centerville,



24-21. The Wildcats also won titles in 1992, 1999, 2001, 2008, and 2011 in front of adoring Wildcats fans in the historical stadium.

During years in which the Wildcats played at Fawcett, the football program adopted the phrase 58 Miles to Fawcett. The team's 2017 hashtag plays off that theme.

The stadium was renamed Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium after its most recent renovation, completed in August 2017. So, the Wildcats retired the phrase 58 Miles to Fawcett.

With the return of the OHSAA State Championship to Canton, the theme #58MilesToCanton has been adopted. The theme will be used on social media, apparel, and other items. After falling short of a state title in 2016, the Wildcats will look to retun to Canton in 2017 and claim the program's state record 12th state title.
