Coaches Director

General

1. Must maintain a current USA Wrestling and CUSAW coaches' membership.
2. Attend all CUSAW Board Meetings.
3. Be directly accountable to, and communicate regularly with the Board and / or Chairperson.
4. Make a year-end detailed report at the September Annual Meeting or as otherwise requested by the Board and/or Chair.
5. Help with set-up, operation, and take down for all CUSAW sponsored events.
6. Must have a minimum of Bronze Level certification through the National Coaches Education Program (NCEP)

September-February

1. Organize, prepare and initiate any National Coaches Education Program (NCEP) Copper and Bronze certification classes in a classroom setting as needed or requested by membership.
2. Attend the annual CHSCA coaches meeting as a speaker to promote and inform CHSAA High School coaches about CUSAW and NCEP education.
3. Assist any Bronze certified coaches and athletes who are in the process of earning their Silver Level certification.
4. Assist CUSAW coaching members with any membership and/or certification issues.
5. Communicate regularly with USA Wrestling's NCEP manager.

March-July

1. Evaluate and monitor CUSAW coaches conduct at sanctioned CUSAW events.
2. Communicate with Directors and Officials at CUSAW events involving inappropriate conduct by CUSAW coaches.
3. Have an active role in any discipline that may need to be enacted on a CUSAW Coach due to misconduct or inappropriate behavior.
4. Assist Chairperson and Age Director in the selection process for evaluating CUSAW coaches for the National Teams.
5. Continue providing NCEP education classes as needed during FS/GR season.
