### Football

The varsity football team defeated Niles West 40-0 on Thursday night, clinching a playoff birth.

Savontae Garner scored on the Titans first offensive play, running 61 yards for and touchdown. The Titans never looked back.

"I think I was way more explosive and the line stayed on their blocks and did a great job," Garner told the Glenview Lantern. "I was able to get into the hole and get out of there basically."

Garner rushed for 198 yards and scored four TDs.

The Titans are 5-1 and travel to #3 ranked Maine South on Friday, Oct. 6.

"We have to come free and play error-free football," coach Dave Schoenwetter told the Glenview Lantern. "I'm excited about the challenge and I think our kids will be too."

This week the Glenbrook South Boys' golf team participated in the Central Suburban League's golf tournament. The Titans put up their best 18-hole team score of the year with a 299 but came in third behind 1st place New Trier with a 286 and Maine South with a 289.

Scoring for the Titans were senior co-captain Jack Grier with a 74, junior Jack Upperman with a 74, sophomore Aaron Chong with a 74 and senior co-captain Brian O'Connor tying with sophomore Junoh Oh with a 77.

The next competition for the South golf team is the regional match on Tuesday, October 3rd, at the Glencoe Golf Club. To advance to the next level of the state tournament, the sectional match, the Titans must place in the top three teams of the nine that are competing.

The two returning state qualifiers earned a tie for 3rd place as individuals. Sophomore Ysabella Arrojo completed the successful showing with a 93, with Junior Kaki Feerick and Freshman Olivia DeMattia also contributing. Up next for the ladies is the IHSA regionals on Wednesday at Sportsmans' Country Club in Northbrook. Best wishes to them as they move now to the postseason.

Girls Swimming

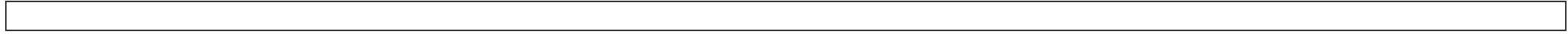
