Alcohol and Drug Policy

The Quad City Hockey Association (QCHA), in alignment with USA Hockey and MWAHA/MSHSL, has a zero-tolerance policy with respect to alcohol and drugs. In addition, there will be no alcohol or drugs allowed inside the River's Edge or Vibrant Arena at the Mark during QCHA-sponsored events, including practices, games, tournaments, Try Hockey for Free, One Goal/Learn to Play and all other QCHA hosted events located within these venues. This applies to anyone in attendance.

Further, no images of alcohol or drugs will be used in conjunction with any QCHA name (including Ice Eagles, Blues, and Lady Blues) or websites, including QCHA social media sites. Violations of this policy should be reported by emailing the disciplinary chair at discipline.chair@quadcityhockey.com. Any QCHA member that is found to be in violation of this policy or other Code of Conduct or USA Hockey Policies will be subject to disciplinary action pursuant to bylaw 10.

Any exceptions to the policy must be pre-approved by the QCHA board.
