The 2018 National Wheelchair Basketball Tournament (NWBT) presented by ABC Medical is at the Kentucky Exposition Center in Louisville, Kentucky, April 12-15.

- If a team does not accept their bid for post season play, invitations will be sent to the next team, in order of ranking, until a tournament is filled.

- 👤 The NWBA 3V3 Tournament will feature two divisions:
  - Championship – the competitive division for athletes who are presently playing Adult Division I, NWBA Collegiate Division, and National Team athletes
  - Open Division – the recreation level player who are athletes who may not get a lot of playing time from the three Adult Divisions, Junior Division and Women's Division.
- 👤 Players that register individually will be placed on teams by the 3V3 Selection Committee. The 3V3 Selection Committee will be comprised of NWBA delegates and divisional leadership. The 3V3 Selection Committee will work to ensure parity for all teams and athletes.
- 👤 Team prizes will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place. Each athlete on the 1st place team will be awarded a \$80 gift card to the NWBA Shop. Each athlete on the 2nd place team will be awarded a \$40 gift card to the NWBA Shop.
- 👤 NWBA 3V3 Rules
  - Court and Ball:
    - The NWBA 3V3 Tournament will be played on half of a regulation court with a GL7X ball.
  - Teams:
    - Each team consists of 3 players. There will be no subs available to teams.
  - Game Officials:
    - Games will consist of 1 or 2 referees and a time/score keeper that will be appointed from the individual players representative entry.
  - Pre-game:
    - Both teams shall warm up simultaneously for 5 minutes prior to the game. A coin flip will dictate which teams will get the first possession.
  - Scoring:
    - Every successful shot inside the arc is worth 1 point. Every successful shot outside the arc is worth 2 points. Shooting fouls will result in 2 free throws per foul.
  - Playing time/ Winner:
    - The first team to score 10 points wins.
    - If 10 points are not met in in the 10 minutes of play, the team with the highest score wins.
    - If tied at the end of regulation, teams will be given a 1-minute rest.

## (Continued 3V3 Tournament Information)

- The first team to score 2 points in overtime wins.
- A team will lose the game by forfeit if at the scheduled start time, the team is not present with 3 players ready to play.
- Game score will be marked “W-0” or “O-W”.
- A team shall lose by default if it leaves the court before the end of the game or all of the players on the team are injured/disqualified. Winning team can choose to have score kept or have game forfeited.
- A team losing by default or forfeit will be disqualified from the tournament.
- Fouls:
  - A team will be given 3 tiers of fouls. The first 4 fouls (non-shooting) will result in a reset for the team that was fouled. Fouls 5 through 7 will result in an automatic 1 free throw opportunity for the fouled team. The eighth foul and beyond will result in 2 free throws for the fouled team along with possession of the ball.
- How Ball is Played:
  - Following each successful field goal:
    - A player from a non-scoring team will resume the game by dribbling or passing the ball from inside the court directly underneath the basket to a place on the court behind the arc.
  - Following each unsuccessful field goal:
    - If the offensive team rebounds the ball, it may continue to attempt to score the ball without returning the ball behind the arc.
    - If the defensive team rebounds or steals the ball, it must return the ball behind the arc (either by passing or dribbling).
  - Check the ball in after every successful basket.
- Stalling:
  - There will be a 24 second shot clock that will start as soon as it hits the offensive players hands
- Time outs:
  - Each team will get one 30-second timeout.
- Protest:
  - Protests will be discussed with the ref and the scorekeeper will make the final decision.
- Standings of Teams:
  - Most wins
  - Head-to-head
  - Most points scored (average)
- Seeding:
  - Will be determined
- Disqualification:
  - Player with 2 unsportsmanlike fouls will be disqualified from the game.
- Finals:
  - The final championship game will last 20 minutes or to 15 points and will be played with the same rules as stated above.
