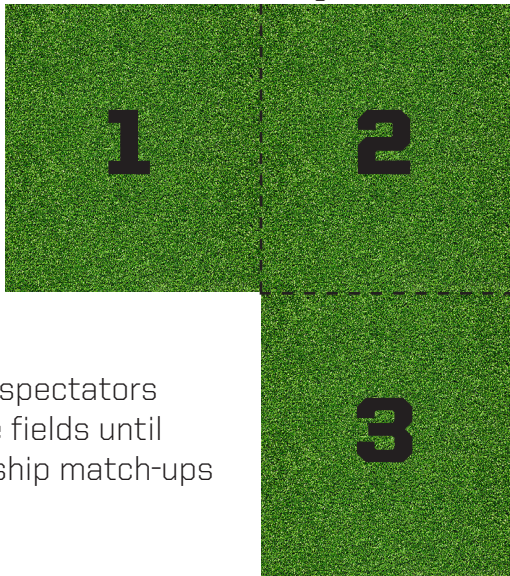

FACE-OFF COMBINE RULES:

- The entire combine will follow NCAA face-off rules for seeding and tournament face-offs.
- All players will make the single elimination tournament to crown a champion in each division.
- Divisions will be split up by grad year:
 - 2018 & 2019; 2020 & 2021; 2022 & 2023; 2024, 2025 & 2026
- Seeding brackets will be created and posted throughout the facility on Sunday at the conclusion of the groups Round Table Sessions.
- All players are responsible for checking the brackets, knowing their seedings, and paying attention to their field assignments.
- Each field will run on a central whistle to begin each face-off match.
- Tournament Specific Rules:
 - The winner gets 1 point per face-off win
 - To get a clean win, you must get possession of the groundball
 - If the ball goes on to another field, gets stuck on the wall in a corner, or is a tie-up it will be the referees discretion to call a re-do on the face-off
 - A violation on the face-off counts as a win for the opponent
 - Through the rounds, each match-up will play best of 11
 - The semifinals and finals of each division will be best of 15
