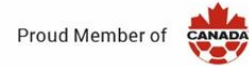

Subject: Update on Member Management Registration solution

Ontario Soccer is providing an update on the full and comprehensive Member Management Registration solution, which is being designed by SportsEngine.

The work in 2017 has focused on responsible implementation to safeguard a disciplined and methodical rollout of the new Membership Management Registration System and transition off of the current A.I.M.S. system, ensuring minimal disruption to Ontario Soccer's Districts, Clubs and Academies.

As part of this responsible implementation, SportsEngine and Ontario Soccer have laid the foundational groundwork for a robust member management solution.

From a Club and/or Academy perspective, a standardized registration template was created with export capabilities to easily import data into A.I.M.S. while A.I.M.S is still in use.

200 plus Clubs, 18 Districts and 16 Academies have provided, configured and entered organizational information into the system in addition to the existing over 60 Clubs, Districts and Academies already having a positive experience utilizing SportsEngine CMS and Member Management Registration system. These members will be incorporated into early-beta across all new solutions.


In 2018, the plan is to ramp up engagement and beta testing for Club, District and Academy participation of the new tools and features being developed with this planned schedule:

Timetable	Action
First quarter 2018	Improved rostering tools and sharing of roster data between organizations.
Second quarter 2018	One time importing of individual registrant information, allowing Ontario Soccer organizations to import data from 3rd party systems as a starting point for the Member Management Registration System allowing a standardized view of all organizational data regardless of primary registration source. Allow participants to register directly on the system at their Club or Academy level. Enhanced Club management, improving the workflow for Clubs and Academies to manage teams and rosters.
Third quarter of 2018	Indirect registration, allowing for Clubs and Academies who accept hard copy forms to enter and record payment for registrations on behalf of their athletes.
Fourth quarter of 2018	Credentials and 3rd Party integration, which provides API integration with third-party providers allowing Ontario Soccer to integrate with existing partners (Respect in Sport, CAC etc.). Digital carding available when a player is rostered.

Additionally, 2018 will focus on automating current processes, such as online sanctioning, data sharing between organizations from the Club to District to Ontario Soccer, with improved and standardizing reporting capabilities.


The Board of Directors of Ontario Soccer will determine the appropriate timing to fully launch the new SportsEngine system.
