ISWA REMINDERS



The following are some reminders of ISWA policies

- Beginning in the 2016-2017 wrestling season, all coaches wishing to gain access to be
 matside during any of the ISWA State Events will be required to hold BOTH a USA Wrestling Coaches membership card and a Copper level or above Certification.
- All ISWA sanctioned tournaments are required to hold weigh-ins. The safety of the athletes is of the upmost importance. To ensure that each athlete is wrestling someone of the like size, athletes need to weigh in. There are many different ways to hold weigh ins: on-site, off site (or satellite), and faxed weigh-ins. This is a very important part of wrestling and is part of the rules of sanctioned events set forth by the ISWA.
- Freestyle State Finals Qualification- It is required by the ISWA that all athletes wishing to
 compete in the Indiana Freestyle State Finals qualify for the event by competing in 2 local
 Freestyle tournaments with in the state of Indiana. To qualify a wrestler must participate
 in the tournament by wrestling, simply registering for a tournament will not count as a
 qualifying tournament.
- Anyone attending a Copper Coaches Clinic will be required to hold a USA Wrestling
 Coaches membership card (this has always been required for Bronze courses) Purchasing this card requires a background check, so please be sure to have this taken care of plenty of time before the Clinic to ensure the background check has processed (this may take up to 2 weeks).
- There are new weight classes for the Women's Cadet and Junior age division

- Cadet: 94, 100, 106, 112, 117, 122, 127, 132, 138, 144, 152, 164, 180, 200

All memberships will continue to be purchased online through USA Wrestling's membership site at usawmembership.com. The fee is \$40.00 and credit cards only will be accepted. To purchase your card, please visit *iswa.com* and click *Get your wrestling card*.

A user ID and password are required for all previous members. The USER ID is your wrestling card number from last year. This number will not change from year to year. All previous members have a password assigned by USA Wrestling, if you do not know your password please call or email the ISWA office.

Birth Verification is required for NEW MEMBERS ONLY!

New members will need to verify their date of birth by submitting a copy of their birth certificate to the ISWA office. Once the office receives proof of birth your card will no longer show pending in the system.

Note: Wrestlers born 9/1/1997 or before are considered Adults and must purchase an Open License Membership card at a cost of \$50.

USA Wrestling, the National Governing Body for Wrestling in the United States, has delegated the Indiana State Wrestling Association the right, duty and responsibility to develop, conduct, sanction and promote all state and local programs in the state of Indiana.

The ISWA will provide a program for all age divisions (Pee-Wee/Veteran). Membership and insurance for all wrestlers and clubs will be provided through the state association by USA Wrestling. All wrestlers will receive a USAW Competitor's Membership Card. This affords our wrestlers the opportunity to participate in all ISWA scheduled tournaments and events. In addition, a USAW membership card is honored at all USA Wrestling events throughout the US.

All members are entitled to Secondary Sports Accident Insurance

This policy is an excess or **secondary** coverage policy. "Secondary" means that if the injured member has other insurance, that insurance is automatically "primary" and they must pay the incurred costs first. In order to be eligible for any secondary sports accident insurance benefits, you must have followed all requirements and conditions under your primary carrier including any "in-network" requirements.

USA Wrestling sports accident insurance will pay benefits up to the policy limits after the deductible has been paid and the 80-20 co-insurance condition has been met (see below). If the injured member has no other insurance, the USA Wrestling secondary sports accident insurance applies, with the same coverage amount and deductible described below. All valid claims must first be filed with the injured's primary insurance company regardless of the type of claim. In order for benefits to apply the injured party must receive medical treatment within 90 days from date of injury. All claims, and subsequent benefits, if any, are subject to verification by USA Wrestling's National Headquarters of each membership benefits. No benefits will be extended under the secondary coverage, if you do not follow any and all requirements of your primary including any and all "innetwork" requirements.

Deductible

This policy includes a \$500 deductible per injury. Each membership period, in terms of the deductible, begins September 1 until September 1 of the next year.

Co-Insurance Limits

This policy has the following co-insurance conditions: Plan pays 80% and injured party pays 20% per valid claims, after the \$500 deductible. Once the member has met the \$500 deductible, and has paid an additional \$2,000 out of his/her own pocket (which does not include the \$500 deductible) in a Benefit period, which runs from September 1 to September 1 of the next year, plan pays 100%.

An application can also be downloaded by selecting Clubs located under the Membership button on the home page. If you choose you may mail your application and fee to ISWA, P.O. Box 157, Beech Grove IN 46107. Please make checks payable to ISWA. USA Wrestling has acquired COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE/UMBRELLA

LIABILITY POLICY, which provides coverage for USA Wrestling chartered clubs. The combined liability

limit for these policies is \$5,000,000 per occurrence. All clubs will receive a General Liability Certificate of Insurance. This proves that your club has insurance and states coverage limits. Many facility owners/operators will ask for this proof as a condition of you using the facility.

The owner/operator of a facility may also ask to be listed as a Certificate Holder on a Certificate of Insurance. This gives the owner/operator proof that you have insurance and states that they will be notified of any changes. You can also submit an application to name an Additional Insured. Additional insured entities are extended the same coverage as the chartered club. Schools, school districts, and facility owners/operators often ask to be an additional insured.

TOURNAMENT RULES, REGULATIONS & STATE MODIFICATIONS FOR CONDUCTING A SANCTIONED EVENT

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR ALL SANCTIONED EVENTS

- 1. Tournaments hosting an ISWA/USA Wrestling event must require all competitors to hold a USA Wrestling competitor's membership card.
- 2. A USA Wrestling Competitor's card or proof of purchase must be presented when registering
- 3. Pee-Wee, Bantam, Intermediate, Novice and Schoolboy wrestlers <u>CANNOT</u> move up an age division. Cadet age division wrestlers who are in high school may move up to the Junior age division. Senior age division wrestlers CANNOT move up to Veteran. However, persons qualified for the Veteran age division may wrestle in Senior age division.
- 4. Entry forms must include a participant's wavier and release as well as a signed consent (by a parent or guardian if they are under 18) for emergency medical treatment.
- 5. Out-of-State wrestlers may compete in ISWA open events and preliminary tournaments provided they are duly registered with USA Wrestling. The ISWA STATE FINALS Series is open to INDIANA RESIDENTS ONLY!! Under no circumstances will out-of-state wrestlers be allowed to participate in any ISWA State Final. In case of a protest, full-time Indiana residency must be verified to the Tournament Committee. Indiana school enrollment will determine residency if other verification is unavailable or not satisfactory. The wrestler will then have to produce a copy of their report card or school ID to participate.
- 6. Weigh-ins for all age divisions will consist of 1 weigh-in and 1 immediate challenge. Wrestlers will not be allowed to leave the weigh-in room. A wrestler may move up one weight class from the weight in which he/she is qualified to compete in at the time of weigh in.
- 7. Mouth guards and headgear are required during competition at ISWA sanctioned events for wrestlers participating in Pee-Wee through Schoolboy/girl age divisions. Non-compliance may result in elimination from the tournament.
- 8. Pee-Wee age division wrestlers will be governed by the same rules as Bantam through Schoolboy/girl.

 All modifications imposed by USA Wrestling for Bantam through Schoolboy/girl age divisions will also apply to Pee-Wee age division wrestlers.
- 9. A wrestler must be allowed at least 15 minutes after a bout before he/she can compete again.
- 10. Athletes must weigh-in wearing a competition singlet. No school attachment is allowed
- 11. With the exception of the State Finals, weight classes may be split at the discretion of the local tournament host.
- 12. Certified Athletic Trainers will be on site to conduct skin checks during weigh-ins at all state final events.
- All decisions by the trainers, regarding participation, will be final! (For details go to iswa.com and select Tournament/Sports Medicine from the top menu. Sports Medicine information includes Skin Check information and a Physician's Release for Wrestlers.)

FOLKSTYLE SPECIFIC MODIFICATIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS NFHSA

Rules will apply with the following modifications:

- 1. All corrections of errors MUST be settled with the official/head official at mat side using the guidelines per NFHS Rules. **No judgment issue will be reviewed.**
- 2. The ISWA recommends that line bracketing be used at all Folkstyle events where there are 4 or more in a weight class. Vertical pairing is recommended for 3 or less. Copies of bracket sheets, flow charts, etc. are available for printing on the ISWA web site: **iswa.com**

FREESTYLE OR GRECO-ROMAN SPECIFIC MODIFICATIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS The FILA rules in the "International Rule Book," as modified by USA Wrestling, are to be followed at Freestyle and Greco-Roman events.

- 1. The "Vertical Pairing System" with positive points or Line Bracketing may be used at events.



It is widely known that training in the Olympic styles make you a better Folkstyle wrestler. Most, if not all, of the top wrestlers, coaches, and programs in the country at every level know and enforce this. They don't train in all three styles because they *are* good, they train in all three styles to BE GOOD! Although Indiana has had national success in Folkstyle, we could achieve even more on the national level if we had more opportunities to train all three styles.

If we are truly dedicated to getting better in our sport, one must understand the wrestling season does not just end in February. It continues on through July, culminating with the Asics/Vaughan Cadet & Junior National Championship in Fargo, ND. This tournament is the largest amateur wrestling tournament in the world, featuring the country's best-of-the-best competition, and is the single largest recruiting event in the nation with college coaches from every division and every corner of the United States.

Indiana's success at this tournament sets the tone for the scholastic season both locally and nationally, and is the primary measuring stick for Indiana wrestlers in comparison to the rest of the country. There are also many other national tournaments leading up to this event including both the Cadet and Junior National Duals, USAW Regional Tournaments, etc. that are available for Indiana wrestlers to participate in.

Indiana's success on this national stage is the focus of our RTCs. They will primarily be designed, not just as a place where local athletes can train together in the international styles, but where we are preparing for this national stage with higher expectations. We are confident these additions, coupled with the direct guidance of USAW and the US World Team Staff, will put us on course to solidify ourselves as one of the top states in the country.

Athletes looking to continue their growth in wrestling, are aspiring to contend for Team Indiana or compete at the higher levels, including on the national stage and in college, are all urged to attend as many RTCs as possible.







Team Indiana kicked off the week in the Greco competition by taking on Team Kansas. Indiana would drop that bout, but rebound with a big win over Ohio Blue, 44-25. Team Indiana would drop their next two bouts to finish 6th in the pool and sending them to the next day of competition to compete in the Red/Blue Pool. On day 2 of the Greco Duals Indiana would drop close matches to Virginia 41-38, and Pennsylvania

2016 Junior National Dual Championship Indiana Recap Nick Hull – Team Leader coachnhull@gmail.com



Team Indiana placed 23rd out of 29 teams in Greco-Roman, while in Freestyle Indiana Gold placed 22nd out of 39 teams and Indiana Blue paced 38th. The following information are notable areas of this event in relation to Team Indiana and the 2016 USAW Junior National Dual Championships.

This was the first time Indiana took two teams in many years. Granted, it wasn't filled and our best weren't there, but being able to even ENTER two teams is a big step in the right direction for Indiana. Georgia was our equivalent this year regarding teams and numbers. We did have one 7 man team, where 8 was the requirement, and that was a special privilege they gave to us because we had some guys get injured who couldn't compete before weigh-ins. They also, similar to some other national duals this year, created a pool for some of the smaller teams to get additional matches so it worked out for everyone. We had the choice to put everyone on one team, but then there would have been several weights with too many guys and kids would have walked away with only a couple of matches, so I just kept the second team. On the other hand, if our best guys were there, or even more guys were there, or even the guys who committed that backed out (valid or invalid) were there, this would not have been an issue. Still, taking two teams is a step in the right direction for Indiana for sure.

Ohio beats Illinois in the Freestyle Finals. This was bittersweet to us personally. Sweet because Ohio won and we believe our best top to bottom can roll with Ohio. Bitter because here we are at the national dual tournament and our neighboring states were in the finals facing each other, and good ol' Indiana stuck right in the middle was not even close. Major difference? A loaded question, but the simple answer is the vast majority of their best kids came. Ohio beat New Jersey, who were loaded themselves, in the semi-finals in a last match nail-biter and were able to get on an early roll over Illinois in the finals. Illinois was missing a few studs and it showed, but still handled their business as usual. Having these teams in the finals only emboldened our Indiana wrestlers even more to come back and roll harder. They took it a little personal....as they should.

Indiana Greco. The same thing holds true in Freestyle, but it is more prominent in Greco: forfeits kill us. We aren't well versed in Greco as a state (problem) but with a full line-up we would have surely done better than 23rd. Still, we had less forfeits than past years and our finish showed as we placed higher than in past years. One year not too long ago we placed 32 out of 33 in Greco. Several guys stepped up to get into the greco line-up, some guys even bumping up, primarily for the 4 pound allowance and because we needed it. The guys that didn't get in on the greco wish they would have because it looked fun, for the allowance, and because the alternates made it less of a grind.

Yes, we were lacking fundamental Greco basics which needs to be addressed as a state, but simply filling a full greco team next year is first and foremost.



Indiana Freestyle. If we had all of Indiana's best guys we genuinely would have had a shot to win it, or at least All-American, but we didn't so we had to play the hand we are dealt. On a positive note, every kid who went wrestled their hardest and wrestled tough. Every wrestler who went learned what they need to do to get better. It is easy to keep doing the same thing when you're winning conference titles in Indiana, but when we get exposed against the best of the best in the country it definitely humbles the best of us. Technically, we still can't stop a gut consistently, aren't on the level for consistent 4 point moves, or able to gut ourselves, we still mostly shoot with our head

down and stop (folkstyle), along with several other issues Folkstyle does not penalize us for - but being able to point out these habits to our kids will benefit them greatly as they make the adjustments and will be that much stronger for the H.S. season. Next year we will look to fill, at least the first team (starting with Indiana wrestlers who have separation criteria) by the time of the 2017 IHSAA State Tournament in February. Alternates to that team will come after the State tournament and we will use the ISWA State Tournament to fill the second team and finish filling the Greco Team.

Alternates are necessary. Some coaches, parents and kids questioned in the past why we would take alternates but again, if anyone saw every match, let alone be in the atmosphere, this tournament is a GRIND!!! It's tough enough to go lose once or twice being suplexed on your head, but losing time and time again, and STILL having to go out there expected to perform at a maximum level is extremely challenging for most of our kids physically and mentally. Alternates help us stay fresh, healthy and safe, which is necessary because of the truly high-quality competition and overall length of this tournament. Again, going greco and freestyle for 4 days straight against this level is something the majority of Indiana kids aren't used to.

Coaching Staff. Shout out to Coach Bradley (Marian University), Travis Pascoe (Indiana University), Ben Wissel (Duke University) and Coach Myers (Hamilton Heights) for investing in this team. Having them on the staff helps the kids not only get more exposure to college coaches, but when they are all saying a lot of the same thing in regards to what we need to do to better perform against this level of competition, it rings a little bit louder in the kid's ears. My goal is to keep this same group together at least for another year or two, and possibly bring in a few more elite level coaches to help fill the team, push the privilege, and sell the exposure of this event for our kids.

On another note, I spoke with and interviewed Andrew Howe, who helped coach Illinois, along with several other coaches I know/saw from Michigan, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, Purdue, Minnesota, etc. and about a dozen D2, D3, NAIA and Juco programs about their thoughts of Indiana. BIG shout out to Coach Tom Erikson too who came to support. This legend in USAW and Oklahoma for that matter, was the previous Team Leader before spearheading Lyon University, came and sat at almost every single dual to watch and support our kids. I find this significant because he could have been wandering around recruiting like the other college coaches who weren't currently coaching a state team, but instead chose continue his support of Indiana - essentially in his home state! That's love...as well as the #22pushupchallenge he did with the team was pretty cool.

Parents. Parents. Awesome, without a doubt, and absolutely necessary. The Brady's came out and even bought a cooler and stocked it with supplies, food, drinks, etc. Coach Bane of Richmond came out and supported Alston and the rest of the team, which was great to have his presence and even demeanor out there. Indiana native stud Alex Warren made the trip to support Christian and the team as well, which was cool as he wrestled at this event in the past. Mama Mappes, bless her heart, was the sweetest thing and rooted on all the boys. The Barclay's were off in the cut too and having them there only helped further strengthen our presence. I realized that if we are going do this, better organization and preparation on my side is going be needed with the parents. I realized it too late but if a parent volunteered (work the camera or clock for the team) then they could get in free. Their help was never needed so they got the chance to basically get in free. But after tasting this parental support this year, it isn't going anywhere and is only going to amp up.

Great Team Experience. These guys were silly. From the knuckleheads to the silent assassins, it's always fun getting guys together from across the state, different regions, schools, personalities, etc. The interaction between successes is invaluable. The more successful kids directly and indirectly raise the expectations of the newer kids who haven't necessarily had that success, and this just feeds the cycle of building the culture and ultimately Indiana's success and reputation. The higher Indiana's success and reputation at this level, the more colleges will recruit Indiana kids. This trip with



Indiana's "best" has just as much team camaraderie as any other trip and it is also a big component for Indiana's culture. It was stated earlier about Indiana's best kids pulling the other best kids to help fill this team, and they are absolutely correct. Only having a few seniors was tough but it allowed our Juniors and younger guys (many of which will be among Indiana's top guys next year) to bond, take this event personal, and amp up to spread the word and come back next year with a vengeance.

Venue. From our understanding, this tournament may be up for bid? We heard something about a two year-cycle. Wouldn't it be awesome if the USAW Junior National Dual Championships were held here in Indiana? I think about how much easier it would be to get Indiana's best from a quality, quantity and financial standpoint, give Indiana fans, coaches and wrestlers a chance to see this level up close and personal, more top flight coaches stepping on Indiana soil, etc. There are a lot of possibilities. On the other hand, the Schoolboys are here and I think we had forfeits on that team as well? It would take a lot of work to pull this off and that is a major commitment for the ISWA, although it could be done. Either way, the location could ultimately affect the cost of this trip for us and possibly who and how many we take. Oklahoma gets it mostly because they want it and prepared to do it, from multiple cities inside the state, but there are some other states who will end up bidding for it.

Team Leader. I am personally looking to lock guys in by IHSAA state for the Gold Team, push more kids to train F/G and participate at Freestyle State for the Blue Team, utilizing more recruiting avenues, providing better training opportunities throughout the summer with the RTCs, getting team sponsors to make it cheaper for kids, working closer with coaches to fill the team, being a little stricter with the selection process, etc. These are just a few of the things I will take a look at to have a better showing out here. Although I don't think we could do it, but I wouldn't even be opposed to giving the guys who made this trip first right of refusal for next year's team just to insure this year becomes at least par. Either way, it should take a collective effort. Trust, however, that in no way are we satisfied with these results even remotely. The kids who went are not either. We will make the proper adjustments and come back bigger and better next year. Given the opportunity, my ultimate goal is to help Indiana win the Team National Championship and/or all-American three years in a row.

Conclusion. In Freestyle, Indiana Gold placed 22nd and Indiana Blue placed 38th out of 39 teams. Indiana Greco placed 23rd out of 34 teams. We have several wrestlers who made the All-Dual Team and even more who beat some national ranked guys, multiple time state champions, etc. It was fun and every single person got better. Still, we need to get all of our best guys. We need to get more guys on the team. It needs to be cheaper. We need to be better prepared. Those 4 areas ultimately requires a culture shift for the state as a whole, as an organization, as coaches, parents, individual wrestlers, and getting outside of one's comfort zone is never easy. But, then again, nothing epic ever happens in the comfort zone. Regardless, Indiana should be proud of these boys.


2016 Fargo Cadet Freestyle & Greco National Team






The Cadet Freestyle team came away with a 15th place finish out of 48 teams. We were carried by 3 All-Americans; **Lucas Davison**














2016 Fargo Junior Freestyle & Greco National Team








