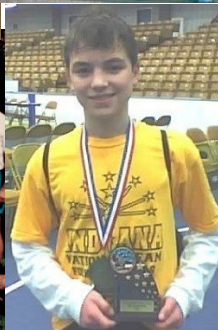

ISWA WRESTLERS EARN 104 MEDALS at the 2017 IHSAA STATE FINALS

A large number of wrestling fans turned out for the 79th Annual Indiana High School Athletic Association's Individual Wrestling State Finals held February 17-18, 2017 at Banker's Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis.

At this competition, the IHSAA awarded a total of 112 medals to wrestlers placing 1st through 8th, of that total – 104 were ISWA members!

ISWA REMINDERS



The following are some reminders of ISWA policies

- **ALL coaches wishing to gain access to matside during any of the ISWA State Events will be required to hold BOTH a USA Wrestling Coaches membership card and a Copper level or above Certification.**
- All ISWA sanctioned tournaments are required to hold weigh-ins. The safety of the athletes is of the upmost importance. To ensure that each athlete is wrestling someone of the like size, athletes need to weigh in. There are many different ways to hold weigh ins: on-site, off site (or satellite), and faxed weigh-ins. This is a very important part of wrestling and is part of the rules of sanctioned events set forth by the ISWA.
- Freestyle State Finals Qualification- It is required by the ISWA that all athletes wishing to compete in the Indiana Freestyle State Finals qualify for the event by competing in 2 local Freestyle tournaments with in the state of Indiana. To qualify a wrestler must participate in the tournament by wrestling, simply registering for a tournament will not count as a qualifying tournament.
- Anyone attending a Copper Coaches Clinic will be required to hold a USA Wrestling Coaches membership card (this has always been required for Bronze courses). Purchasing this card requires a background check, so please be sure to have this taken care of plenty of time before the Clinic to ensure the background check has processed (this may take up to 2 weeks).
- The weight classes for the Women's Cadet and Junior age divisions are as follows:
 - Junior: 100, 106, 112, 117, 122, 127, 132, 138, 144 ,152, 164, 180, 200, 225
 - Cadet: 94, 100, 106, 112, 117, 122, 127, 132, 138, 144, 152, 164, 180, 200

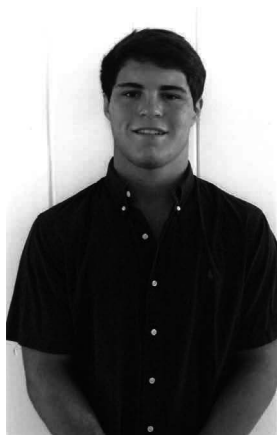

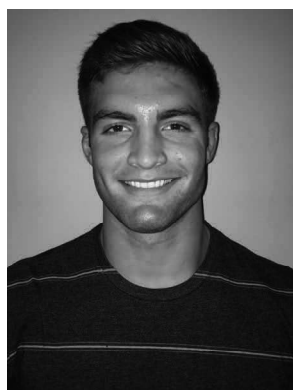

"FOUNDERS SCHOLARSHIPS"

The Indiana State Wrestling Association of USA Wrestling, Inc. (ISWA) takes pleasure in offering the "Founders Scholarship." This program is available to graduating high school seniors who qualify for and are selected to receive this award.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. The applicant must be a current member of the ISWA and must have participated in the program the immediate previous year.
2. Must be a graduating high school senior.
3. Must have an average or above average academic standing. (Applicant must provide a transcript of up-to-date grades).
4. Must show a personal interest in their community. (Enclose a letter of reference including name, address and telephone number).
5. Has been accepted by a College or University or has applied to attend a College or University.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

1. Complete the APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP and return it along with a photograph to the designated address.
2. Submit, in your own words, your specific college and future plans.
3. Write a brief essay stating why you should receive this scholarship.
4. Your application must be filed (postmarked) by April 1st.
5. Scholarships will be submitted, in their name, to the school where the recipient is enrolled, unless other arrangements are made.
6. Should the recipient not continue on to a higher education the funds will revert back to the general scholarship account.
7. Feel free to use additional paper in your response to any of the questions appearing on the scholarship application.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

A minimum of four \$1000.00 Scholarships are awarded annually.

The deadline for all applications is April 1st.

All applications become the property of the ISWA and will not be returned.

The selection committee will inform all applicants of its decision by JUNE 1st.

Rollie Hoover Memorial Scholarship

In 1998, the ISWA Board of Directors voted to award an annual scholarship to a graduating high school senior, who in addition to being a good student, contributed to the ISWA as an official.

Rollie Hoover suffered a fatal heart attack on his way to referee a tournament in Helsinki, Finland. Wrestling was one of Rollie's loves. He touched many lives whether it was coaching his 1968 Elkhart Central team to a state championship or teaching a new move on the mat, he was always unselfish and willing to share his vast knowledge with anyone willing to learn.

Rollie was a mentor for many young referees. He was usually the first to arrive and the last to leave. You could always find him on the mat with a young referee. His willingness to work with young people to help them develop as referees, wrestlers, and most of all as human beings was evident to all who know him. Rollie had a way about him that did not intimidate a new official, even though he held the highest US category, M1 Exceptionelle, and the international category of FILA1.

Rollie was a charter member and two time past president of the Indiana High School Wrestling Coaches Association, the recipient of the Billy Thom Award for service and the ISWA John Hurrle Award.

John Schattner Memorial Scholarship

In 2012, the ISWA Board of Directors voted to award an annual scholarship in John's memory. John left behind a lifetime of friends. John was someone who was always helping others. John was a skilled and respected math teacher, wrestling coach and an athletic director.

Anyone connected with wrestling in Indiana knew who John was. John was an IHSAA wrestling official for 40 years. His distinctive deep voice could be heard resonating across the entire gym. John served as the transportation director for the ISWA for many years. John was a lifetime member of the ISWA. John also received the John Hurrle Award.

John organized trips to the NCAA Wrestling Finals for Indiana officials and coaches which he attended for the last 25 years. John was also a member of the Indiana Wrestling Hall of Fame. John mentored new officials as they worked their way into the wrestling community.

John also officiated football, volleyball and track and was a cross country meet starter. John was a fixture at numerous CYO contests over the past 40 years. John was involved in his own prison ministry, visiting dozens of inmates over the years, as well as transporting prisoners' families to and from prisons for visits.

John was loyal to all of his friends. John made sure his mom felt special and loved. John did that for a lot of people in the wrestling community.

Mike Dowden Memorial Scholarship

In August 2013, the ISWA Board of Directors voted to award a memorial scholarship in the name of Mike Dowden.

Mike was instrumental in establishing the ISWA and served on its board of directors for 28 years, with 26 of those years as the State Chair. Upon retirement, Mike was made a lifetime member of the ISWA. Mike also served on the board of USA Wrestling. Mike received the ISWA John Hurrle Award as well and was a member of the IHSWCA Hall of Fame.

Mike's name was known throughout the country for his hard work and integrity in the wrestling world. Mike could be counted on to make sound decisions, always with the wrestlers best interest in mind.

Mike touched many lives throughout Indiana and the rest of the country and will be missed for his insightful input.

USA Wrestling Competitor's Membership

All memberships will continue to be purchased online through USA Wrestling's membership site at usawmembership.com. The fee is \$40.00 and credit cards only will be accepted. To purchase your card, please visit usawmembership.com

A user ID and password are required for all previous members. The USER ID is your wrestling card number from last year. This number will not change from year to year. All previous members have a password assigned by USA Wrestling, if you do not know your password please call or email the ISWA office.

Birth Verification is required for NEW MEMBERS ONLY!

New members will need to verify their date of birth by submitting a copy of their birth certificate to the ISWA office. Once the office receives proof of birth your card will no longer show pending in the system.

Note: Wrestlers born 9/1/1998 or before are considered Adults and must purchase an Open License Membership card at a cost of \$55.00.

USA Wrestling, the National Governing Body for Wrestling in the United States, has delegated the Indiana State Wrestling Association the right, duty and responsibility to develop, conduct, sanction and promote all state and local programs in the state of Indiana.

The ISWA will provide a program for all age divisions (Pee-Wee/Veteran). Membership and insurance for all wrestlers and clubs will be provided through the state association by USA Wrestling. All wrestlers will receive a USAW Competitor's Membership Card. This affords our wrestlers the opportunity to participate in all ISWA scheduled tournaments and events.

In addition, a USAW membership card is honored at all USA Wrestling events throughout the US.

All members are entitled to Secondary Sports Accident Insurance

This policy is an excess or **secondary** coverage policy. "Secondary" means that if the injured member has other insurance, that insurance is automatically "primary" and they must pay the incurred costs first. In order to be eligible for any secondary sports accident insurance benefits, you must have followed all requirements and conditions under your primary carrier including any "in-network" requirements.

USA Wrestling sports accident insurance will pay benefits up to the policy limits after the deductible has been paid and the 80-20 co-insurance condition has been met (see below). If the injured member has no other insurance, the USA Wrestling secondary sports accident insurance applies, with the same coverage amount and deductible described below. **All valid claims must first be filed with the injured's primary insurance company regardless of the type of claim. In order for benefits to apply the injured party must receive medical treatment within 90 days from date of injury.** All claims, and subsequent benefits, if any, are subject to verification by USA Wrestling's National Headquarters of each membership benefits. No benefits will be extended under the secondary coverage, if you do not follow any and all requirements of your primary including any and all "in-network" requirements.

Deductible

This policy includes a \$500 deductible per injury. Each membership period, in terms of the deductible, begins September 1 until September 1 of the next year.

Co-Insurance Limits

This policy has the following co-insurance conditions: Plan pays 80% and injured party pays 20% per valid claims, after the \$500 deductible. Once the member has met the \$500 deductible, and has paid an additional \$2,000 out of his/her own pocket (which does not include the \$500 deductible) in a Benefit period, which runs from September 1 to September 1 of the next year, plan pays 100%.

An application can also be downloaded by selecting Clubs located under the Membership button on the home page. If you choose you may mail your application and fee to ISWA, P.O. Box 157, Beech Grove IN 46107. Please make checks payable to ISWA.

USA Wrestling has acquired COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE/UMBRELLA LIABILITY POLICY, which provides coverage for USA Wrestling chartered clubs. The combined liability limit for these policies is \$5,000,000 per occurrence. All clubs will receive a General Liability Certificate of Insurance. This proves that your club has insurance and states coverage limits. Many facility owners/operators will ask for this proof as a condition of you using the facility.

The owner/operator of a facility may also ask to be listed as a Certificate Holder on a Certificate of Insurance. This gives the owner/operator proof that you have insurance and states that they will be notified of any changes. You can also submit an application to name an Additional Insured. Additional insured entities are extended the same coverage as the chartered club. Schools, school districts, and facility owners/operators often ask to be an additional insured.

TOURNAMENT RULES, REGULATIONS & STATE MODIFICATIONS FOR CONDUCTING A SANCTIONED EVENT

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR ALL SANCTIONED EVENTS

1. Tournaments hosting an ISWA/USA Wrestling event must require all competitors to hold a USA Wrestling competitor's membership card.
2. A USA Wrestling Competitor's card or proof of purchase must be presented when registering
3. Pee-Wee, Bantam, Intermediate, Novice and Schoolboy wrestlers **CANNOT** move up an age division. Cadet age division wrestlers who are in high school may move up to the Junior age division. Senior age division wrestlers CANNOT move up to Veteran. However, persons qualified for the Veteran age division may wrestle in Senior age division.
4. Entry forms must include a participant's wavier and release as well as a signed consent (by a parent or guardian if they are under 18) for emergency medical treatment.
5. Out-of-State wrestlers may compete in ISWA open events and preliminary tournaments provided they are duly registered with USA Wrestling. The ISWA STATE FINALS Series is open to INDIANA RESIDENTS ONLY!! Under no circumstances will out-of-state wrestlers be allowed to participate in any ISWA State Final. In case of a protest, full-time Indiana residency must be verified to the Tournament Committee. Indiana school enrollment will determine residency if other verification is unavailable or not satisfactory. The wrestler will then have to produce a copy of their report card or school ID to participate.
6. Weigh-ins for all age divisions will consist of 1 weigh-in and 1 immediate challenge. Wrestlers will not be allowed to leave the weigh-in room. A wrestler may move up one weight class from the weight in which he/she is qualified to compete in at the time of weigh in.
7. Mouth guards and headgear are required during competition at ISWA sanctioned events for wrestlers participating in Pee-Wee through Schoolboy/girl age divisions. Non-compliance may result in elimination from the tournament.
8. Pee-Wee age division wrestlers will be governed by the same rules as Bantam through Schoolboy/girl. All modifications imposed by USA Wrestling for Bantam through Schoolboy/girl age divisions will also apply to Pee-Wee age division wrestlers.
9. A wrestler must be allowed at least 15 minutes after a bout before he/she can compete again.
10. Athletes must weigh-in wearing a competition singlet. No school attachment is allowed
11. With the exception of the State Finals, weight classes may be split at the discretion of the local tournament host.
12. Certified Athletic Trainers will be on site to conduct skin checks during weigh-ins at all state final events. All decisions by the trainers, regarding participation, will be final! (For details go to iswa.com and select Tournament/Sports Medicine from the top menu. Sports Medicine information includes Skin Check information and a Physician's Release for Wrestlers.)

FOLKSTYLE SPECIFIC MODIFICATIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS NFHS

Rules will apply with the following modifications:

1. All corrections of errors MUST be settled with the official/head official at mat side using the guidelines per NFHS Rules. **No judgment issue will be reviewed.**
2. The ISWA recommends that line bracketing be used at all Folkstyle events where there are 4 or more in a weight class. Vertical pairing is recommended for 3 or less. Copies of bracket sheets, flow charts, etc. are available for printing on the ISWA web site: iswa.com

FREESTYLE OR GRECO-ROMAN SPECIFIC MODIFICATIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS

The FILA rules in the "International Rule Book," as modified by USA Wrestling, are to be followed at Freestyle and Greco-Roman events.

1. The "Vertical Pairing System" with positive points or Line Bracketing may be used at events. Copies of Wall charts, work sheets, flow charts, etc. are available for printing at iswa.com
2. The ISWA strongly suggests that a "Blind Draw" be used at all local tournaments.

7. May have 2 high school workers working together
8. No wrestler competing may work until the completion of their wrestling for that day
9. Points will only be given if the required sheet is completed and turned in prior to 4:00pm on the Wednesday before the state tournament
10. Points will be given once requirements have been met
11. Must work the entire event until released by tournament staff

Weigh-ins

Weigh-in times are as follows (EST):

Girl's participating in both FS on Saturday & Girl's FS on Sunday may weigh-in on Friday night for both events.

All weigh-ins will consist of (1) weigh-in and (1) immediate challenge. Wrestlers will not be allowed to leave the weigh-in area. The ISWA does not charge for adjusting weight classes after you register. You are free to adjust your weight class at any time, even at weigh-ins. All athletes must weigh-in wearing a competition singlet. (Women's singlet as specified by the NFHS' guidelines)

Skin Checks:

Upon arrival, wrestlers will proceed directly to skin checks and weigh-ins. Certified Athletic Trainers will be on site to conduct skin checks prior to weigh-ins. All decisions by the trainers, regarding participation, will be final! (For details go to iswa.com and select Tournament/Sports Medicine from the top menu. Sports Medicine information includes Skin Check information and a Physician's Release for Wrestlers.)

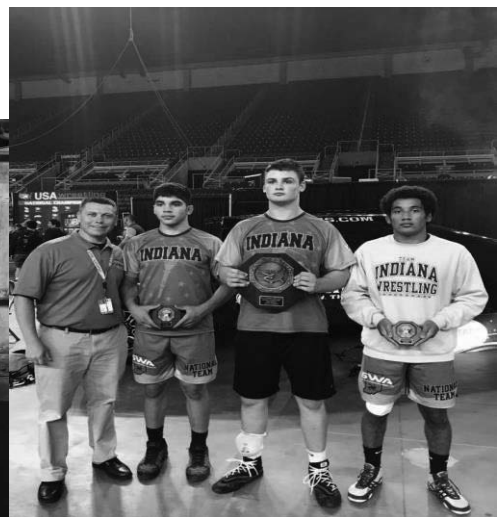
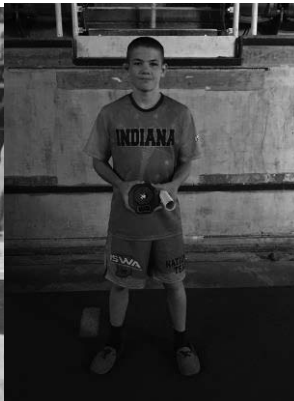
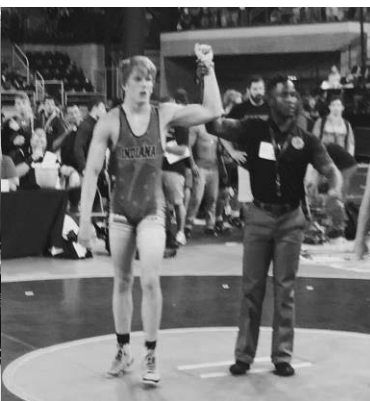


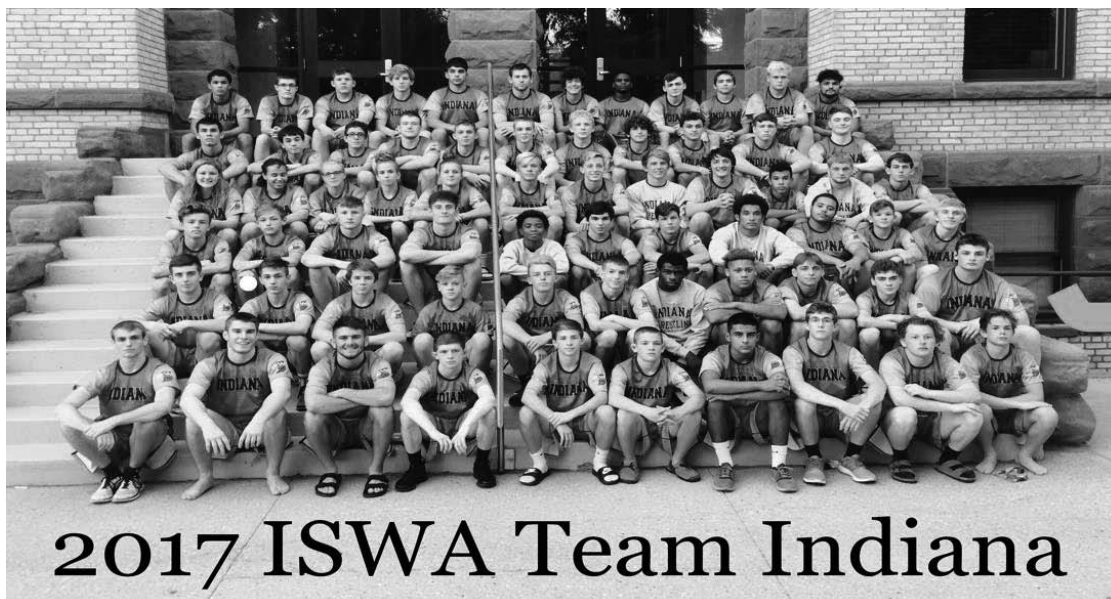


2017 Fargo Cadet Freestyle & Greco National Team
