



Results from the KCIC Adult Hockey C League Captains Meeting
Held on Sunday December 31st, 2017

Ten of the twelve teams were represented at the New Year's Eve captains meeting to discuss some of the issues that our rapid expansion has created.

A two-tiered C Division playoff was approved.

The top 4 teams will play in the A bracket, while the next 8 teams will play in the B bracket.

A bracket - (4th vs 1st and 3rd vs 2nd)

B Bracket – (12th vs 5th / 11th vs 6th / 10th vs 7th / 9th vs 8th)

New 45+ Senior League (for established veteran players currently playing in the A / B / C leagues)
This will be a competitive league for established, veteran players. League starts on January 15th.

C league captain's voted unanimously to play out the second half of the season – as is. Meaning no changes to any team's roster, for the remainder of the season.

C league captains voted unanimously to re-establish an oversight competition committee to set up guidelines that will allow teams in ranking their players (on a scale of 1-6). Every team captain will be part of the competition committee. This committee will begin the process immediately of determining individual player rankings that we will use starting next session.

Competition Co-chairs - Opossums team captain, Jeff Smith and Timberwolves team captain.

Note: Divisions could change next year based on final standings. For example it's possible that we would have two 6 team divisions (while some crossover play remains a possibility). This is another area that the competition committee will be reviewing. Their goal – to return the league to a more "overall" competitive balance.
