Poor Sportsmanship & Unacceptable Player Behavior, <u>at a minimum</u>, will be assessed the following consequences:

Player First Offense

Player Meeting & Verbal Warning, One Game Suspension

Player Second Offense

Parent / Player Meeting, Two Game Suspension, Removal as Team Captain or Asst Captain

Player Third Offense

Dismissal From The Team for the remainder of the season.
