SAM KLEIN MEMORIAL 3-ON-3 HOCKEY TOURNAMENT TOURNAMENT RULES and FORMAT

RULES:

All players 18 and under are required to wear HECC approved helmets and facemasks and mouthguards. Players over 18 are required to wear hockey helmets. All players are required to wear shin guards, hockey gloves and hockey skates. Elbow pads, breezers and shoulder/chest pads are recommended.

Players may only play on one team.

Minimum no. of players on a team is 3 and maximum is 6.

All goals must be scored from the attacking side of center ice.

There will be no offside or icing.

One referee will be used in the game and penalties will be enforced: any minor penalty (tripping, slashing, etc.) will result in a goal for the non-offending team and a change of puck possession.

Any major infraction (fighting, intent to injure, etc.) will result in ejection from the tournament.

There will be no body checking or overt body contact, minor penalty will result.

Slap shots are prohibited. If a stick comes above the knee in a slap shot motion it will be deemed a slap shot and a minor penalty will be assessed plus a change in possession.

There will be no raising the puck above the knees. Intentionally raised pucks will result in a change in possession.

Making contact with the puck using your stick above the waist will result in a change of possession.

There will be no goalies or goaltending equipment (goalie skates are allowed).

Players may not lay their stick, lay on the ice or drop to their knees to protect their goal. Players must remain on their skates in front of the goal. No more than one player can occupy the space in front of the net. A goal for the other team and change of possession will result.

If the puck leaves the playing area the referee will award possession to the non-offending team at the point where it left the ice. The defending team must allow 2 stick lengths away from the puck carrier until the referee signals (whistles) play to begin.

Center ice face-offs will start the game and the second half. Otherwise, defensive teams will wait on their side of center ice after goals and penalties. Defensive teams can engage the offensive team once play begins to move up the ice.

FORMAT:

All games are 2, 12 minute halves and are running time. With a 2-min. Pre-game warm-up and no change in ends.

Ties at the end of regulation time will result in a 2-minute sudden-death period.

Format (Round-robin, double elimination, etc.) will be determined after registrations are in and number of teams are determined. Trophies will be awarded to the winners in each division.
