Player Agent Role and Process

#### Player Agents

- The objectives of the player agent are:
  - To place players with on team with proper managerial/coaching support
    - <u>League Directors</u> are accountable for soliciting Managers and Coaches
    - A manager is needed for every team.
      - The manager is the lead parent for that team.
      - It can be done by committee, but one person must serve as the manager
    - Make sure that there are coaches for each team.
      - Prefer that there are at least 2 coaches for every manager, more is even better.
  - Make placing players with their fellow school mates a priority
    - When a school has enough for multiple teams, it works best to have the manager divide the players
      - Note: Manager assigned team need to be balanced no all K team and an all 1<sup>st</sup> grade teams
    - When we have extra players or player at a school that doesn't have enough for team, we try to keep those players together.
    - When assigning players classified as "other", we try to align to the neighborhood if possible...closest school team.

# Team Formation - Data handling

- Create a Team Column by
  - Duplicating the School column
  - Then changing the header to "team"
    - The team column will make the process easier to manage
    - We will want preserve the school reference later and
- Sort by the team name and players last name
- Sub total based on team name
- Note the team counts




