Girls Basketball

The girls' basketball team swept its three games this week and moved its record to 18-6.

The Titans defeated Vernon Hills Wednesday night 63-45. Kristin Ralston scored 17, Lizzy Shaw 13, Libbie Vanderveen 11, Makayla Stadler 7, Liz LaPierre 6, Molly Sedin 5, and Annie Streb and Katherine Chu 2. The girls dominated host Niles North 74-32 on Friday night, as 20 Titans received playing time. Shaw led the Titans with 14, followed by Ralston with 13, LaPierre with 12, Vanderveen and Chu with 6, Stadler, Sedin, and Julia DiSano with 5, Annie Streb with 4, Halle Smith with 3, and Janet Watson with a free throw.

The Titans played their best all-around game of the year on Saturday afternoon, defeating MSL-leading Hersey 48-32. The Titans received terrific defensive efforts from Stadler, Shaw, Vanderveen, and Flaws, who pestered the Huskies' guards all afternoon and made it difficult to enter the ball. Post defenders LaPierre, Ralston, and Smith were also dominant, making every touch a tough one for the Hersey inside players. The 32 points were Hersey's lowest output of the year. Stadler, Vanderveen, and Shaw recorded key steals in the fourth quarter to put the game away. Ralston led the Titans with 13, Vanderveen scored 12, Stadler added 10, LaPierre dropped in 8, and Shaw netted 5.

The Titans take on Prospect at home on Wednesday night and welcome league-leading New Trier on Friday.

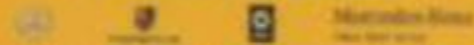

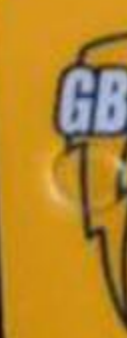
