CODE of Ethics

These are the rules and expectations of our players, parents, fans and coaches. This organization and any person associated with it will strictly follow these principles.

Coaching Philosophy:

Parents will support your Coaches job of teaching these principles:

- We will work to instill discipline and respect in our players.
- We will work to develop a will to compete in our players.
- We will foster a sportsmanship environment.
- We will work to instill concept "Team" over "Me".
- We will encourage the enjoyment of playing but competing to win

Player Expectations:

- Parents will support Discipline, Respect, Responsibility
- Players will respect authority and fellow team members.
- Players will be required to Listen and Follow instruction.
- Players will be responsible for their own equipment and behavior.
- Players will be expected to Hustle and have a Good Work Ethic.
- Players will be expected to follow appropriate dress and appearance rules.

Parent Expectations:

- Parents will be a Positive Role Model and Supporter.
- Always show support for child and team and encourage them to have fun.
- Refrain from negative comments concerning players, team or coaches.
- Refrain from unruly behavior- Always advocate good Sportsmanship.
- Advocate the continued commitment to practicing and competing.
- Advocate player responsibility for their own equipment and actions - Help them mature.
- Refrain from coaching .
- Expect your child to listen and respect his coaches, team and opponents.
- Commit to having your child at practice and games on time.
- If a player is going to be late or absent, Notify the coach ASAP.

Parent Complaints:

- Make sure they are Legit and Important. Must be made to the Head Coach.
- If Problem is not resolved, after speaking with head coach, Jimbo Tate (League President) will be informed.
- Playing time and positions are decisions of the coaching staff.
- Players and Parents are not guaranteed When, Where or How often a player will play.
- Coaches will strive to be objective and fair to all players.
- Never approach a Coach during or immediately after practice or game. There is a time and place for everything.
