TRAC Winter League Rules

- The league will run for 6 weeks, from Feb. 11th to March 23rd with first games starting at 6pm on Sunday nights and 7pm on Fridays
- Only 9 fielders allowed
- No infield fly rules
- Slide at your own risk, ***TRAC or Jamestown Softball is not responsible for injury***
- No cleats (Molded or Metal) Allowed, turf shoes are okay and recommended.
- Bat as many players as desired, 8 minimum. Games may begin with 8 players but no more than 9 in the field.
- Pickup players must be on an active TRAC Bubble League roster.
- All balls batted off the ceiling above the blue in the bubble are considered live balls and playable. A ball is considered foul if it hits the blue in foul territory.
- If a ball hits the white and lands in foul territory, the ball is considered foul.
- If a ball hits the blue in fair territory, it is then considered a live ball and play continues, much as if the ball had hit a fence.
- The black border around the Bubble is considered an extension of the turf. If a ball hits that in fair territory, it is the same as if it hits the fence, live ball.
- A Defensive player may not step or jump onto the black base of the bubble.
- A ball that is batted and hits a suspended speaker or light in both far and foul territory is a live ball, unless it lands in foul territory.
- In order to keep pace of play moving, there is a **limit of 10 runs per inning.**
- 5 innings per game
- 45-minute time limit on games, no inning can be started after time limit has been reached, however, an inning can be finished after the time limit.
- 50 ft. base paths
- Use any bat you wish
- 0-1 count to start the at-bat.
- Balls and strikes will be determined by a pitching mat placed behind home plate. If any pitched ball hits the mat in anyway, it is considered a strike. There will be no arc limit to pitches.
- A pitcher's box will be implemented. A Pitcher may pitch the ball from anywhere in the box he or she wishes.
