MEDICAL CONSENT FORM AND LIABILITY AGREEMENT

In the event of accident, injury or illness involving my child named as participant above; while partaking or traveling to a Crestview Area Youth Association ("CAYA") event or while participating in any activity sponsored by or under the auspices of a CAYA function under circumstances where I am physically unable to consent or am not present:

1. I hereby voluntarily authorize and consent to the furnishing the above named child such medical care, attention, and treatment by any hospital, physician or dentist as such hospital, physician or dentist may deem necessary or advisable, including any x-ray examination, anesthetic, medical, or surgical diagnosis or procedure.
2. I authorize any adult associated with the CAYA program to consent to such medical care, attention and treatment should consent not be available from an adult family member.
3. I agree to pay the reasonable cost of such medical care, attention or treatment and to indemnify and hold free and harmless of and from any and all liability for such cost: the assisting adult, the Crestview Area Youth Association, executive officers, facility providers, members and sponsors of said organizations.

It is understood that all effort shall be made to contact the undersigned prior to rendering treatment to the patient, but that any of the above treatment will not be withheld if the undersigned cannot be reached.

PARTICIPATION RULES AND CODE OF CONDUCT FORM

Participant's Responsibilities - The participants of the CAYA program are expected to abide by a code of conduct that includes but is not limited to the following:

- Respect of volunteer coaches, team members, opponents, officials and other representatives involved with the CAYA program.
- Participants will take proper care of the equipment that is issued to them to use. Immediately notify a coach if the equipment becomes damaged.
- Good sportsmanship is mandatory. No vulgar language, displays of anger or fighting will be tolerated. Any such actions will result in disciplinary measures and may include suspension from the team.
- As a participant of the CAYA program you represent yourself and your teammates on and off the field. Whether in victory or defeat you will conduct yourself with pride and poise.
- Always be willing to help your coach or teammate when required. This program is for you!
- Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in forfeiture of participation by the player.

Family Responsibilities - The level of support given to a participant by the parents will have a measured impact as to the success of each child and the program. To better understand the parent's role and involvement in the program, we have developed the following guidelines and recommendations:

- Parents and visitors at practices, games and or cheer competitions must stay in designated areas reserved for the spectators. Sideline areas, practice fields and locker rooms are off limits.
- Parents are encouraged to cheer for their teams from the stands with enthusiasm but should never yell obscenities or derogatory remarks aimed at the opponents or conduct themselves in an offensive manner. As a result of such action, a team can be penalized for unsportsmanlike conduct and the fan may be removed from the grounds.
- A large number of people are needed to help. Members of the participating families are required to volunteer a portion of their time during the season to help make the program run efficiently.
- It is the family responsibility to provide transportation to and from practice, games and other association functions.
- If a participant's grades fall below a "C" average or homework starts to become a problem, the family should notify the head coach and together determine the best course of action to be taken.
- Parents should always maintain a cooperative attitude towards coaches, participants, officials and board members. Remember that all are volunteers!!
- Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in forfeiture of participation of the player and/or parent.
