I/We, the parent(s) or guardian(s), in consideration of your organizing as a minor football League and in permitting my/our child to play, waive any right to action that I/we may have on behalf of my/our child for any cause whatsoever and agree that this waiver may be pleaded as an estoppel to any action against the League or any members of it including any coaching, managerial or administrative personnel of the said League. I/We further agree that I/we shall waive harmless, protect and indemnify the League, or any members of such League from any action that may be brought as a result of injuries of any nature whatsoever incurred by my/our child. Furthermore, I/we hereby forever release, discharge and hold harmless the National Capital Amateur Football Association (NCAFA) and its membership, representatives or agents for any injury, loss or damage to my/our personal property howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with my/we taking in football activities and not withstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the NCAFA and any of its membership, representatives or agents.

The Ontario Government has enacted Rowan's Law (Concussion Safety), 2018, S.O. 2018, c. 1 ("Act"). Ontario Regulation 161/19, the Act requires all sport organizations as defined in the Regulation ("Sports Organization"), to have a Concussion Code of Conduct. This Concussion Code of Conduct must require participants, as set out in the Act, to review the Ontario Government's issued Concussion Awareness Resources on an annual basis. A participant is subject to a Concussion Code of Conduct for each Sports Organization a participant registers with.

Athletes under 26 years of age, parents of an athlete under 18, coaches, team trainers and officials need to follow the rules of Rowan's Law as follows:

- review any one of Ontario's official Concussion Awareness Resources before registering or serving with your sport organization; and
- review the Ontario Football Alliance's Rowan's Law Policy including the Concussion Codes of Conduct.
