Jersey Colors: The higher seeded school will wear LIGHT jerseys.

Shoreland Lutheran will wear DARK jerseys.
Whitewater will wear WHITE jerseys.

Player Bench/Practice Balls: Player benches will be assigned so teams are shooting at the basket in front of their bench during the

second half of play. Do not bring any basketballs. The host school will provide your team with basketballs

for warm-ups.

Participants: The maximum number of participants for each game is 18. Coaches must verify their squads at the scoring

table.

Trainer: A certified athletic trainer will be working. Teams need to provide their own supplies.

Buses: Buses should enter the circle from South Elizabeth Street, and teams should unload at the east end of the

building at the athletic doors. The gym is located on the east end of the building. Buses should park on

Noisemakers/Recorded Music/Laser Pens: Air horns, whistles and devices that simulate gunfire are not allowed. Noisemakers and recorded music may not be used during playing action. Tournament managers may restrict the use of noisemakers and/or recorded music interfering with or disrupting athlete/coach/official communication or use of any devices that are excessively loud. Laser pens are prohibited at all WIAA regular season and tournament contests. Violators shall be removed from the contest and laser pens confiscated.
