



GBN Hockey 2018 Spring Program

The GBN Spring & Summer Hockey Program is open to all present GBN students and those entering Glenbrook North this coming Fall, that have a 2003 or earlier birth date.

Spring Program

The spring program will consist of eight 10 -14 games against local High School teams and 2 -4 practices. We will field a JV and Varsity team based on evaluations and the number of committed players. **Players who are interested in playing on a SPRING TEAM will need to be committed to the game schedule** (most home games will likely be on Sunday evenings; away games are not yet scheduled) We understand that GBN Spring sports (LAX/Baseball) will take priority over Spring hockey. We expect those that sign up will make most of the games scheduled and we **do not** offer a fractional fee based on availability.

Tryouts will take place in early April. Time TBD (check website)

The cost for the **spring program** is **\$530** (goalies are 50% off) and **registration will be available on line only end of February**. Payment in full required when registering. You must register prior to Tryouts.

Summer Conditioning Program

Players will be required to work out independently all summer and turn in specific completed workout reports to Coach Evan. It is assumed that many will be playing other GBN sports over the summer and workouts/activities associated with those sports will count toward workouts. In addition there will be TC Boost sessions available for an additional cost. Off-ice conditioning run by GBN Coaches will begin in July. 10 to 15 sessions are planned, weather permitting. Additionally, GBN coaching staff and Skills instructors will run (10) seventy minute on ice clinics and conditioning sessions beginning about 7/31 and running through August.

The cost for the **Summer Program** is **\$195**. **Registration will be on line only. Payment in full required.**

IMPORTANT - There will be a mandatory meeting for all players and parents in early April in order to explain the Spring/Summer programs and coached expectations going into the fall season.
