7) NEW BUSINESS:

• Rink news from the new rink manager Jeff.

Coaches need to be in control of their players. Coaches need to be held responsible. No floor hockey has been enforced. The rink is not a playground or a babysitter. The families do need to be taken care of. Doug – In regards to the U8 floor hockey problem, in a lot of rink arena have an area for floor hockey. Is there a place in this rink we could have a designated area for floor hockey? There will be more changes on the inside of the rink to come. It can be looked into as it happens. Is there a possibility of having ice in the summer? It costs the city \$12,000 a month just for electricity for the ice. Jeff is looking into partnerships to reduce prices of the electricity. Looking into another sheet of ice in a more efficient building. Jeff would like to stretch the ice longer and earlier. Opening as early as they can.

Introducing curling and broomball. The rink is buying used curling stones from Laramie. Trying to acquire a malt beverage permit. There should be 50/50 advertising in the future. The practice schedule looks good. They will help the capitals get more ice time. Doing away with prime time and nonprime time rates. Rate increases for next season? No. Might be a small fee for the Zamboni. The city is getting a 5th penny tax proposal together and could be under parks and recreation. In the summertime looking at doing indoor go carts. The rink has gotten approval to upgrade the miniature golf using \$30k. Also wants to put a go cart track where the train is by the miniature golf. Wants the rink to turn into a family fun center. Will be getting a marquee outside along E. Lincolnway. Jeff wants more hockey functions at the rink to get more skaters to the rink. The parking lot lights are in the works. What can the board members and association do to help you with the rink? Jeff will come to the board and association when we are needed. Jeff would like to pair up with us to submit for the Kraft Hockeyville grant.

Doug would like Krivo to come back. Wolff is now working with Krivo. The camp would be 8 hours a day for 5 days. It would be all age groups.

The Black Hills Hockey Academy did not communicate to the Capitals about the camp being here. It was set up by a Capitals coach. Wolff and Krivo always give money back to the Capitals when they have camps in Cheyenne. Someone needs to communicate with Black Hills Hockey about doing the same as Krivo and Wolff.

The coach in chief needs to decide what camps the coaches want for the Capitals kids.
