



High School Hockey Positions: Director of High School Hockey, Head Coach, Assistant Coach, Franchise Holder

I. Franchise Holder – The current Board President will be the franchise holder for the High School Varsity, Junior Varsity, and Modified teams.

II. Director of High School Hockey – The Director of High School Hockey (the “DHH”) position will be nominated by the Board president and then confirmed by the Board of Directors. The DHH will be responsible for selecting the Junior Varsity Head Coach and Modified Head Coach. The DHH will also be responsible for providing monthly reports to the Board of Directors, (typically during the monthly meeting) to discuss all High School Hockey business. The DHH may hold a Head Coaching position at the same time but is not obligated to be a head coach. This also may be subject to Board suggestions to assist in the direction of the High School program. The Board of Directors reserves the right to remove the DHH at any given time.

III. Head Coach – Varsity Head Coach will be suggested by the Director of High School Hockey to the Board President. The Head Coach will then be nominated by the President and then confirmed by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors reserves the right to remove a Head Coach at any given time.

IV. Assistant Coaches – All Assistant Coaches will be selected by the Head Coach for their respective team. The Board of Directors will not participate in this selection. Like Head Coach, all coaches must pass appropriate background checks and screenings as described by the governing body (AAU) and/or league requirements.

High School Hockey Procedures

I. The selection process for the High School Hockey and Modified teams will be determined by the best skilled players regardless of age. The Junior/Senior privilege does not apply and will not guarantee a position over an under classmen.

II. This selection will be determined by the Head Coach of the respective team, with oversight from the Director of High School Hockey. In the situation where the DHH and Head Coach are one in the same, the Head Coach may provide an assistant coach to help with the player selections.

III. In the event of a disagreement on selection from the player or parents, a protest will not be accepted. The High School Hockey Program does not recognize protests.



IV. Playing time is not guaranteed. All fees are binding no matter how often a player receives ice time or how often a player is able to attend practices or games.

V. Disciplinary actions will be addressed as follows: Any and all minor infractions or internal issues will be addressed and handled at the discretion of the Head Coach. If an issue becomes a major infraction or if the Head Coach deems that the situation warrants additional input or oversight, such as property damage or physical abuse, the Board and DHH reserve the right to require a hearing to be conducted by the Board of Directors disciplinary committee to decide on any appropriate penalty. This will be determined on a case by case basis. Any necessary hearing will be scheduled and conducted as soon as practicable and within a reasonable period following the infraction.
