

S.C.O.R.E. is an educational achievement program that recognizes student athletes that achieve a 3.0 minimum GPA (a B level) and up during the hockey season. If your Squirt/U10, PeeWee/U12, or Bantam/U15 child has a GPA of 3.0 or greater, they qualify for the S.C.O.R.E. Program.

If your skater qualifies please submit your child's report card to: BYHAScore@BuffaloHockey.net no later than Saturday, March 10th. (Please note that this is an optional program and all information will be kept confidential.)

How to determine the GPA of your child

If your school uses a number system add up the grades and divide by the number of classes. See example

Class	Grade
Math	4
English	3
Social Studies	3
Gym	4
Music	2
Totals	16

So this student had 5 classes and the grade total for those 5 classes was 16, to determine the GPA we take 16 and divide it by the number of class (5) which give us a GPA of 3.2 and they would be a skater that qualifies for the S.C.O.R.E. Program

If your school uses the standard letter grade system, use the chart below to determine a numerical value for each of your child's grades. Once you have a number to correspond with each grade, add them together and divide them by the number of classes. This will give you the GPA, see example

Class	Letter grade	Numerical grade
Math	A	4
English	B	3.
Social Studies	B-	2.667
Gym	A+	4.33
Music	A	4
Science	B+	3.33

Totals		21.327

So the student above had 6 classes and combine numerical total for those 6 classes was 21.327, to find the GPA we divide the 21.327 by 6 which gives us a GPA of 3.5545 and this student would qualify for the S.C.O.R.E. Program.

If your school uses a combination of numbers and letters, you convert the letters to numbers and leave the numbers as numbers. See below

Class	Letter grade	Numerical grade
Math	C	2
English	3	2
Social Studies	2	2
Gym	A+	4.33
Music	A	4
Science	3	3
Totals		17.33

In the above example we converted the letters to numbers using the below chart and left the number grades as numbers. We then added everything up to get a numerical grade total, as before we will divide this total by the number of classes to get the GPA, 17.33 divided by 6 gives us a GPA of 2.8883 and does not qualify for the S.C.O.R.E. Program
