## GIRLS SUMMIT

This event was held on March 15th and there was strong turnout. Recruitment and retention were a major focus. A number of different ideas came out of this meeting and committees were formed to help tackle the major issues and move forward.

## GOALIE NIGHT

Looking ahead to next year it is clear we are short goalies for a few levels. This idea came up as way to give players a chance to try being a goalie. We want to thank and the coaches, parents, players, PDC members, and Board members who came out to make this a successful event. We will plan on doing this again in the fall.

## TROIS TRAINING

We had Rob come to our meeting to get a better understanding of how they have worked with different associations to help with goalie specific training. He explained they typically have 3 - 4 sessions before the season starts and 2 - 3 a month after that until January. This results in approx 10-12 sessions with a 3-1 player to coach ratio. The cost for their services are approx. \$3,000.00. We could scale it back depending upon our financial situation.

After Rob left the meeting PDC discussed this in more detail. We have struggled with finding goalie specific over the years and have cycle through a number of them. One part on the TROIS training program is that they welcome our coaches to be on the ice with them and to observe their training and learn from them.

It is the recommendation of PDC to the Board to proceed with TROIS for the 2018-2019 season.
