



7. Guest Playing for Outside Club Policy

IFC encourages guest play opportunities and has an open guest play policy. Any IFC player invited to guest play for a team outside of IFC must go through and get approval from the Director of Coaching, or his or her designee, before participating with that club/team.

Permissions will only be granted if all player's fees and financial obligations have been fulfilled to the Club and Team. The following process is mandatory in order to have an IFC player to participate in any capacity with another team.

1. The head coach desiring the participation of a player must direct a request in writing, phone call, or e-mail to the head IFC coach of the team that the player is currently rostered
2. The individual contacted must grant approval for such participation to ensure that the guest play does not interfere with team obligations prior to the player partaking in any event or activity with the other club
3. If the request is granted, then the outside club's coach works with the DOC and Registrar to ensure that appropriate paperwork is completed for insurance purposes and player pass loans
4. No IFC Team Manager or Registrar will directly hand any player/family their player card if they have not completed the above three steps.
5. Player pass will be checked-out for 72 hours.
6. Non-compliance with the guest playing provision by a coach shall be deemed both unethical and a violation of the recruitment provision. A player that participates in any event or activity as a guest player without the permission of their current coach or director of coaching shall be subject to disciplinary action.
