New for 2024: Dibs on SportsEngine

- Dibs replaces SignUp for volunteering with KYFL
- Why the Change?
 - Dibs will streamline both the sign up process and receive credit when you volunteer.
 - You will be able to see how many credits you have already volunteered
 - · Credits will be awarded weekly for completed volunteer shifts
 - No added cost to families. Registration is increasing this year, but not because of administrative improvements like this.
- Back by popular demand: Volunteer credit will be given for announcer, scoreboard, and chains.

Volunteer Positions Full Credit

- · Head Coaches: Football and Cheer head coaches needed for all age levels.
- Assistant Coaches: Assist Head Football and Cheer coaches at all age levels
- Team Parent: One per team or cheer squad. Serving in this role fulfills your volunteer responsibilities. No other hours are required. If you have any questions about the responsibilities this position entails, please contact the volunteer coordinator.

Volunteer Positions Per Shift Credit


- <u>Concessions:</u> Assist with preparing, serving, and selling food during games and events. This can include set-up and/or clean-up. Please note, volunteers must be in high school older. No one under the age of 12 allowed behind the concession's tables.
- **Spirit Wear:** Sell KYFL spirit wear during games. This can include set-up and clean up. Volunteers must be 16 yrs. old or older.
- Ground Crew: Pickup trash around the field and in the bathrooms. Change trash bags around the field and the bathrooms.
- <u>Field Tear Down:</u> Work with the Field Coordinator to tear down the yard markers, sound equipment, etc.
- <u>Game Day Announcer:</u> The announcer will use our sound system to play music, introduce our players, introduce the visiting team, halftime sponsor announcements, and general action of the game. The position is loads of fun for the right personality who is not afraid of a microphone. Complete training and tutorials will be made available to any individuals.
- <u>Scoreboard</u>: Sit with game day announcer and run the scoreboard. This involves maintaining the game clock. Knowledge of the game of football is helpful but not required!
- Chain Gang: Staff the chains or down marker
- **Special Events:** Additional opportunities will be available to assist with Pep Rally, Homecoming, Showcase and more!


Dibs: STEP 1 – Login to Sports Engine

- Go to www.KYFL.com and click on Sign In
- Login with your SportsEngine login



Dibs: Step 2 – Go to Dibs


- In the toolbar at the top, click on <u>Dibs</u>
- In the available Sessions section you will see the current season, click on the 2024 Regular Season
 Volunteer



Dibs: Step 3 – Find a Dibs Item (List View)

- You can use the filters on the List View to search for opportunities
 - Filter by a **date range**
 - Filter by a specific <u>Category</u> (Concessions, Spirit Wear, etc)
 - Filter by only unclaimed positions using the **Status**.


2024 Regular Season Volunteer




Dibs: Step $4 - \text{Sign } U_{2024 \text{ Regular Season Volunteer}} \text{View}$

• Once you find a Item that you want to sign up for, click on the **item name**.


Click Claim this Dib Item





Dibs: Step 5 – Complete Sign Up

- Select your **Athlete** from the drop down.
- Enter the name of the person who will be working the shift in Fulfiller
 Name.
- You may put in a phone number, but it is not required
- Enter the **Email Address** you want reminders to be sent to.
- Click Claim Dib Item



Dibs: Step 6 – Volunteer and Track

- Once you complete the shift you signed up for, credit will be given on a weekly basis throughout the regular season.
- You can track your progress by visiting the Dibs page at anytime.
- You can also see your Dibs in your SportsEngine Account.
