

Q: WHAT EQUIPMENT MY PLAYER WILL NEED TO PLAY?

A: For further details, please refer to the "Rules" section under GASL Resources. For practices, you will need to have a ball, water bottle (non-glass), shorts without pockets, shin guards & socks (socks over the shin guards), and cleats are recommended (no baseball or football cleats).

Q: I WANT TO COACH, BUT I DON'T KNOW ANYTHING ABOUT SOCCER?

A: Your player is in good hands! We train all of our volunteer coaches on best practices, ethics and sportsmanship. Each Coach will have a mentor who will have a state or national license. Our licensed Coaching Mentors are qualified to apply safety, education and sportsmanship to your player's soccer experience through the Volunteer Coaches.

Q: WHAT DOES A SOCCER SEASON LOOK LIKE?

A: We call home at McCordsville Town Hall and McCordsville Sports Park. Being powered by Sporting Indiana FC, in the Geist Area, helps us provide fun, quality soccer for any one at an affordable price. Your player (4U-10U) will train one night a week and play on Saturday Mornings. Each player will receive uniforms (jersey, shorts and socks) as well as an end of season award and Field Day at the beginning of the Season. We provide 2 soccer seasons a year, Spring Season (April & May) and Fall Season (August & September).

Q: CAN MY KID PLAY WITH THEIR FRIEND?

A: Absolutely. As long as they are the same age group. The social aspect is a big part of the game. Especially if this will help them like the game more. Taking an anxiety out of the game helps them gain confidence.

Q: WHAT HAPPENS TO MY PLAYER AFTER 10 YEARS OLD?

A: Whether your player excels, just wants to keep playing or looking to develop their game further by extending their soccer journey, please talk to the Director about soccer opportunities. We hope that after U10 your player will be ready to play in our Rec+ or travel soccer programs.

Q: WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN REC+ & REC?

A: Rec+ is now called "Select Soccer". The Select Soccer Leagues are set up to serve recreational players ages 10U to 19U who need a greater challenge or those recreational programs that do not have enough players to create their own league play. A Select League is made up of teams from separate clubs (there could be more

than one team from a club) who do not hold tryouts to form teams. Rec+/Select Soccer also helps kids develop the skills and tools to head into the Travel Program.

Q: WHERE ARE THE REC+/SELECT SOCCER GAMES PLAYED?

A: Home games will be played at McCordsville Sports Park and Lawrence Park (8 minutes West of MSP) in the Fort. All Rec games are played at McCordsville Sports Park or McCordsville Town Hall.
