



2018 End of Season Tournament Rules

1. Regular season ASA rules and Local Ops will apply to the End of Season Tournaments
 - Highest seed will be the Home Team
 - If Local Ops are not followed, the game will be forfeited and the other team will be the winner

2. Seeding will be based on the season standings: The following point system will be used to determine standings in the 8U, 10U and 12U divisions:
 - Win 2 points
 - Tie 1 point
 - Loss 0 points

3. Tie-Breakers: In the event of a tie at the end of the season, the following tie-breaker(s) will be used to determine end of season standings and team seeding for the End of Season Tournament.
 - Two-Way Tie
 1. Head to Head
 2. Total Run Differential
 3. Least Runs Allowed
 4. Most Runs Scored
 5. Coin Flip
 - Three(or more)-Way Tie
 1. Total Run Differential
 2. Least Runs Allowed
 3. Most Runs Scored
 4. Coin Flip

4. Length of Playoff Games will be as follows
 - 8U: 1:00 no new inning
 - 10U: 1:20 no new inning
 - 12U: 1:25 no new inning

5. Championship Game schedules are as follows
 - 8u 8:00am to 9:30am no new inning after 1 hr 10 min.
 - 10u 9:30am to 12:00pm 6 innings or no new inning after 2 hrs.
 - 12u 12:00pm to 2:30pm 7 innings or no new inning after 2 hrs.
 - Closing Ceremonies directly after 12U game (May occur before 2:30 pm)

6. International Tie Breaker Rule(ITB) will be used if any tournament game ends in a tie. The girl who made the last out will be placed on 2nd base and ITB will continue until there is a winner. Once a game goes into ITB, all Local Ops for pitching will be considered met.
7. The 8U, 10U, and 12U Championship games will be professionally announced on Closing Day. 1st and 2nd place trophies will be awarded at the Closing Ceremony.
