THA Program Highlights and Changes

- What Worked (things we want to continue):
- Keeping season Labor Day to 1st week of March.
- Striving for highest level of play for each team within Tier II programs.
- Keeping stratification of offerings and commitment levels between developmental programs, White and Black programs.
- Commitment to skill development with weekly skill clinics.
- Utilization of ice surface using skills format ADM style, half ice and 30/30 instead of full ice.
- Utilization of multi team discounts during tournaments
- Availability for additional ice time during stick and puck.
- Spring clinic and stick and puck game.
- Summer rec.

THA Program Highlights and Changes

• Changes for 2018-2019 Season:

- Improve communication at tryout process for players who made what team.
- Adding additional resources and responsibility with the addition of an Operations Manager Developmental Programs.
- Filling all coordinator roles.
- Ensuring roles and responsibilities are clear including reporting responsibility for accountability.
- Separating Developmental from Travel Programs to focus higher emphasis on appropriate offerings, costs and design.
- Incorporating more game like activities for rec players than pure skill-based elements.
- Moving skills for all ages to same night mid-week alternating Winston and Greensboro.
- Balance practice schedules between Winston and Greensboro more evenly for all teams.
- Ensuring practice and game times are appropriate for ages with start and end times.
- Incorporating goalie skills into regular skills rather than separate night.
- Consistency with weekly Rec league games at all ages throughout the season.
- Addition of additional home exhibition games for travel teams.
- Letting coaches and team managers have greater input on tournament selections
