

SSPYBA Player, Coach, and Spectator Code of Conduct

All players, coaches and spectators are to behave in a manner that reflects the positive fun associated with the game of baseball. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated including:

- Verbal abuse
- Arguing judgment calls
- Physical aggression
- Profanity
- Tantrum-like acts
- Use or tolerate the use of drugs, tobacco, or alcohol
- Disrespect of the property and equipment used at any sports facility, both home and away

In addition, we will take responsibility for our guests and ask they adhere to the above.

Discipline:

Any player, coach or spectator ejected from a game will also be suspended from their team's next game. Further sanctions may be warranted depending upon the behavior.

A second offense will result in suspension from any SSPYBA activity for a period of no less than two weeks.

A third offense will ban the individual from any activity within SSPYBA.

Under special circumstances a person

may petition to rejoin SSPYBA by going in front of 3 board panel review.

SSPYBA will support discipline of other organizations it participates in but will use SSPYBA's escalation if it is

the most severe. SSPYBA reserves the right to change or modify the discipline depending upon the circumstances of the offense.
