



Littleton Hockey Association is looking forward to another successful fall season. The LHA Board wanted to provide our members some background as to the need for the increased registration fees on the upcoming season.

The LHA Board targets the goal of being financially breakeven on the regular season with revenues offsetting program expenses and general operating costs. As you are aware, ice rental is our largest expense. LHA has recently renewed our contracts with our primary rinks. While we believe we have negotiated reasonable long-term rates, we will continue to see a significant jump in ice costs from the prior years. LHA continues to experience increased costs for officials. LHA continues to provide dryland training along with the necessary resources to support its coaches.

LHA receives some funding from fundraising, either at the association level or through its share of team fundraising activities. While these funds could be used to offset general operating expenses, the LHA Board has maintained its policy to have these funds support our scholarship program. The scholarship program promotes the benefits of playing youth hockey to families and players who need financial assistance.

Overall, the LHA Board believes the increase in registration fees is reasonable and allows LHA to keep providing a high quality hockey experience for our players. We believe you will still find LHA's fees to be competitive relative to other associations.
