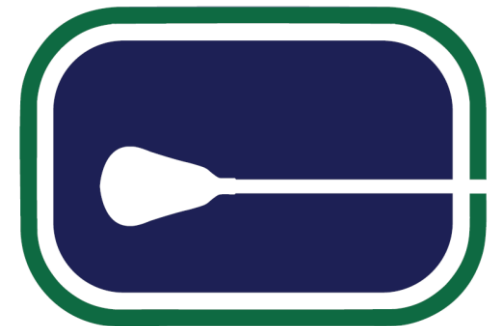

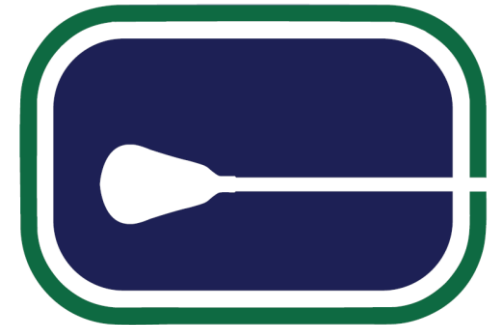
# 2018 Season Overview 8U & 10U

- Outdoor practices will be held at Rahn Elementary
  - Season begins the week of May 28<sup>th</sup> (after Memorial Day)
  - Practices 2 – 3 times per week
  - One week break after Spring Box Jamboree
- 10U Teams will play an 8 game YLM schedule
- 8U Teams will play an 6 game YLM schedule
- Tournament – Eagan Wildcat Faceoff June 29<sup>th</sup> & July 1st
- End of season Jamboree – late July



# 2018 Season Overview 12U

- Outdoor warmup Clinic
  - 5/07 & 5/08 5:30 – 7:30 pm at Northview Elementary
  - Players will be broken out into 2 groups by last name
  - LC from True Lacrosse will be running (Eagan support coaches)
  - \$40 additional cost paid at registration
  - Athletes will need to fill out a waiver that will be sent via email prior to the clinic
- Evaluations
  - 5/14 & 5/16 5:30 – 7:30 pm at Northview Elementary
  - Independent evaluators hired by Eagan Lax
  - Rain dates 5/19 & 5/20 at WSP Dome
- Outdoor practices begin after teams are formed
  - Practices will be held 3 x's per week at Northview Elementary
  - Season concludes end of July
- Teams will play a 10 game YLM schedule
- Tournament – Eagan Wildcat Faceoff June 29<sup>th</sup> & July 1<sup>st</sup> (or TBD)
- Playoffs – State Tourney July 28-29



# 2018 Coaching



- 12U – paid college & HS coaches (graduating seniors) – 2 per team
- 10U – 1 paid assistant coach per team
- 8U – parent coaches
- 1 – 3 parent coaches per team

## Parent Volunteer Coaches

- All U12 and U14 teams may have one parent volunteer 'assistant' head coach who will assist the stipend head coach (see Coach Agreement).
- All U8 and U10 teams may have one parent volunteer head coach.
- All teams may additionally have one parent volunteer defensive assistant and one parent volunteer offensive assistant.
- Head coaches may additionally recruit a parent volunteer or group of volunteers from the team who will be responsible for running goalie drills during regular practices.
- Parent volunteer coaches will take direction from Stipend coaches and help at practices, and act as a Bench Manager during the games.

## **Team Manager**

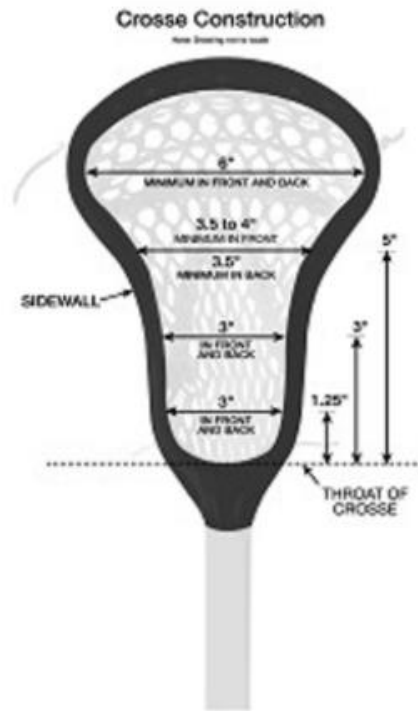
- Manages all aspects of team coordination including liaising with the Summer Field Director, Age Level Coordinators, Equipment Coordinator, Merchandising Coordinator, Coaches, Players & Parents to assure the season runs smoothly for all involved.

## **CHILL Manager**

- According to US Lacrosse, each youth team is required to have a Sideline Manager. A CHILL Manager is YLM's variation of that requirement. A CHILL Manager is a team parent who is responsible for monitoring and enforcing US Lacrosse's and YLM's sportsmanship directives and stands for "Cool Heads Instill Life Lessons". On game days CHILL managers from both teams meet at the scorer's table, remain visible to officials during the game, and politely ask parents/fans to act respectfully towards officials, other teams' coaches and players. They will report unsportsmanlike conduct by players, coaches or fans to [www.youthlaxmn.org](http://www.youthlaxmn.org).
