## WHAT ARE “THE BODIES”?

The bodies are blown up/decorated printed photos of the seniors. Each parent family takes a picture of their child and has it printed and blown up at a print vendor (suggestions below). The picture is attached to fire proof paper provided by the EHS Senior Party Body Co-Chairs. Drawings and pictures can be added to illustrate their child’s personality, activities, interests, or future plans. The bodies are hung in the EHS halls during the senior party as part of the decorations and are sent home at the end of the evening.

## CREATING A BODY

1. Send an electronic VERTICAL photo to a print vendor (suggestions below), affix the printout to fireproof paper supplied by the Senior Party staff, and decorate **OR**
2. Trace a body silhouette (at the Senior Party warehouse) onto the fireproof paper and decorate.

**NOTE: ALL PHOTOS SENT TO THE PRINT VENDORS MUST BE AT LEAST 300 DPI. Less than 300 dpi results in poor quality.**

## DO’S AND DON’T’S

### DO

Use Tacky Glue or Spray Adhesive  
Highlight favorite foods, candy, etc.  
Add pictures of instruments, vacation, sports)  
Use pictures of favorite books or movies  
Add pictures of college names or mascots  
Add pictures of family pets, friends, family members  
Send in a photo with at least 300 dpi

### DON’T

DON’T CUT OUT THE BODY SILHOUETTE  
Don’t laminate the body  
Don’t attach 3D items (photos, clothing, pins)  
Don’t make body larger than fireproof paper  
Don’t send in a photo less than 300 dpi  
Don’t let your senior see the body

## STEPS

1. Pick up the fireproof paper at the EHS Senior Party warehouse during a volunteer shift.
2. Send a full body picture of your student to a vendor for print.
3. Affix the body print to the fireproof paper.
4. Decorate the body.
5. Write your student’s name (first and last) with permanent marker on the back of the head.
6. Drop off the body to the Body Committee during announced drop off dates/times.
