

### Cow Pie Lotto Rules and Regulations

- 1) Cow Pie Lotto will take place on June 2, 2018 starting at Noon on Field 4. "Deeds" will be marked off in a 100' x 100' grid with 5'x5' equally sized squares for a total of 400 "Deeds."
- 2) The grid will be clearly marked with all "Deeds" being equal shape and size.
- 3) No "Deeds" (tickets) will be sold after Noon on June 2, 2018.
- 4) At Noon, the cow will be escorted onto the fenced-in grid area and allowed to freely roam until the first cow pie (not cow pee) is placed by the cow on a 5'x5' square. If the cow has not placed a cow pie within 2 hours, the prize money will be awarded to the ticket holder of the "Deed" where the cow's right front hoof is placed at 2:00 pm.
- 5) If the cow pie lands on bordering "Deeds," the "Deed" with the largest cow pie wins (width and depth).
- 6) A judge will be provided to monitor the event. Said judge is not able to participate in the event in order to remain impartial. The decision from the designated judge will be final.
- 7) "Deed" holders need not be present to win. If winner is not present, the winner will be notified by the phone number provided on the ticket stub and will have 30 days to claim his/her prize. Unclaimed prize money will become property of the Canfield Baseball Club.
- 8) Winner must provide proof of "Deed" ownership and identity (ticket and photo identification/parent and or CBC visual) to claim prize money.
- 9) The winner will receive \$1,000.00. Winner will be responsible for any associated fees/taxes with the cash prize winnings.
- 10.) The event will be held rain or shine with the exception of lightening/thunder, at which time the Cow Pie Lotto will be cancelled. In the event it is cancelled, a randomly selected Canfield Baseball Club player in attendance will be picked and will draw one ticket from all of the sold tickets and the winner will be announced.
