

FOR FIRST-TIME HOCKEY PLAYERS AGES 5-8

Since 2014 over 4,000 kids have been introduced to the game of hockey through the Little Wild Learn To Play Hockey program. Again this year, the Little Wild Learn To Play program will hold sessions throughout Minnesota thanks to the combined efforts of the Minnesota Wild, Minnesota Hockey, HyVee, CCM, Pure Hockey, the NHL, and NHLPA.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- To be eligible for Little Wild 2018, children must be born between September 1, 2013 and September 1, 2009.
- Please note, 5-year old participants must have had their 5th birthday by September 1, 2018 to be eligible to participate. If your child is nine years or older, he/she is ineligible for the Little Wild program.
- The Minnesota Wild highly recommend skating lessons before the start of the Little Wild program. Participants should be able to skate the width of the ice unassisted before the start of their first Little Wild clinic. For more information on skating lessons, please check out your local community education center or ice rinks for classes.
- The program is intended for children who have not participated in organized youth hockey programs before. Children who have registered and played with a local Minnesota Hockey association and/or previously participated in Little Wild are not eligible to participate in the 2018 Little Wild program.
