GBS Girls Varsity Soccer concluded their regular season with a record of 17-3-5.

On Monday, the Titans traveled to Wisconsin and state-runner up Wauwatosa East to upset them 2-0 in an amazing match near Milwaukee. JV call-ups sophomores Sydney Boland and Avery Jerva helped the shorthanded squad. Sophomore forward/midfielder Ellie Flowers got the team on the scoreboard in the 8th minute from a sophomore forward Katie Weiss assist. Sophomore midfielder Boland received a beautiful through ball from junior defender Lizzie Garvey for the insurance goal and win. Goalkeepers junior Libbie Vanderveen and sophomore Jessica Ehlinger shared in a one save shutout against the Red Raiders.

Tuesday brought a rematch versus Deerfield in the end-of-the-season CSL crossover match. The girls survived 80 minutes of regulation, two overtimes of 20 minutes total, and penalty kicks for a dramatic 2-1 victory (4-3, PK's). Junior midfielder Grace Evans amazingly chipped the

goalkeeper from 35 yards in the 8th minute for a 1-0 lead (assist to Katie Weiss). Deerfield equalized in the 51st minute. During penalty kicks, Ellie Flowers, Grace Evans, Hailey Kraabel, and Gracie O'Brien all scored in the shootout. Libbie Vanderveen made a huge save to preserve the victory against #17 Deerfield.

On Wednesday, Maine West was defeated 2-0 in Glenview. Junior midfielder Julia Disano scored in the 43rd minute from a freshman forward Grace Diehl assist. 15 minutes later, Ellie Flowers added her 5th of the season from a Katie Weiss helper to seal the deal. Jessica Ehlinger had one save in the shutout.

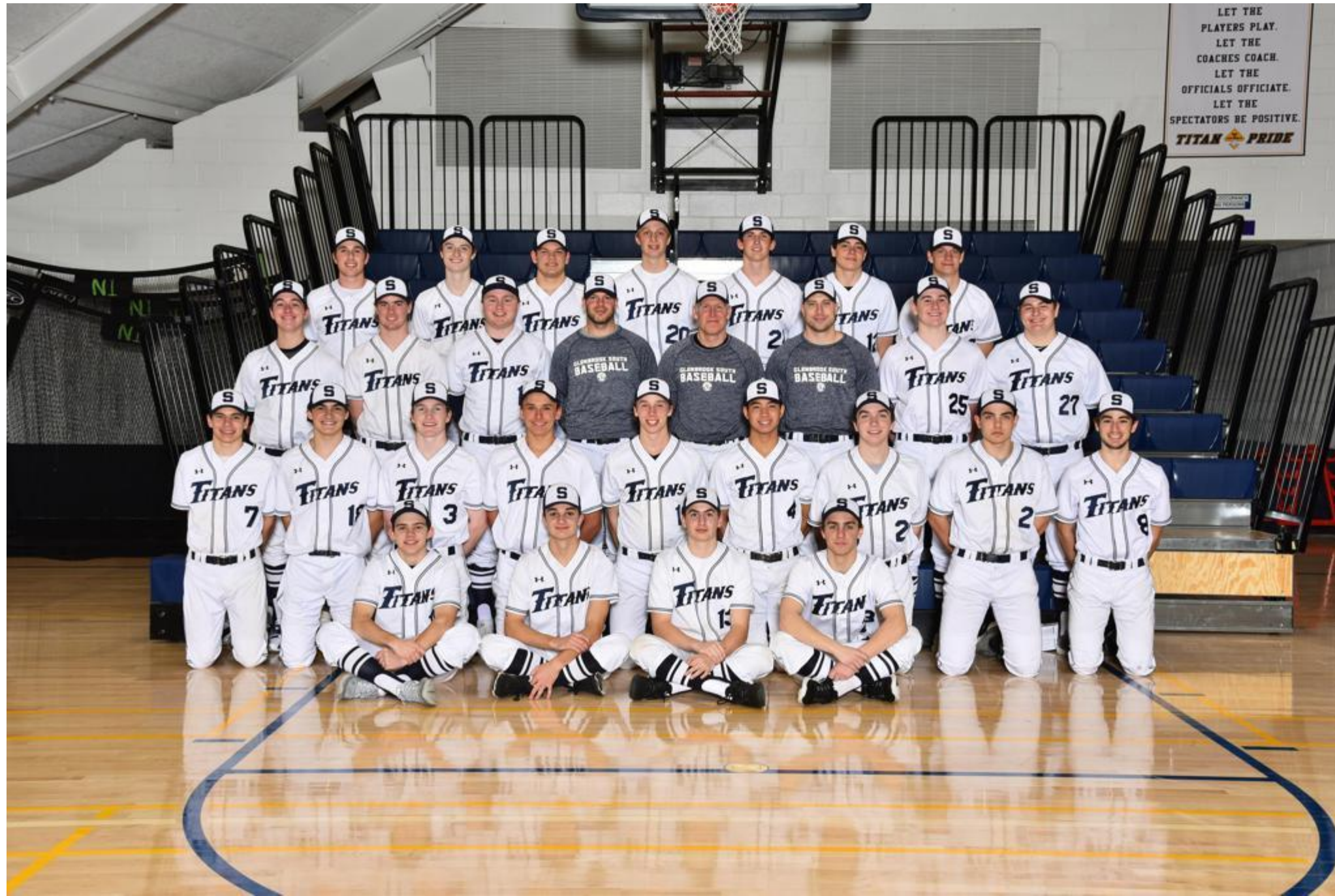

Sophomore Raelyn Roberson finished in first place in the long jump which automatically qualified her for the State Championship meet. She also qualified in the 100m Dash by running a qualifying time of 12.6 seconds.

Senior Emily Noone qualified for the fourth consecutive year in the 800m Run by running a qualifying time of 2 minutes 17.88 seconds.

Sophomore Anne Streb qualified for the second consecutive year in the High Jump by clearing a qualifying height of 5 feet 2 inches.

Junior Taylor Ozimek qualified for a second consecutive year in the High Jump by clearing a qualifying height of 5 feet 2 inches.

Finally, our 4x200 Meter Relay Team: Senior Maddie Batka, Senior Kate Snively, Junior Taylor Ozimek, and Sophomore Raelyn Roberson ran a State qualifying time of 1 minute 44.65 seconds.

These young ladies will compete at Eastern Illinois University on Friday, May 18, at the IHSA State Championship Meet.

Summer Football Camp

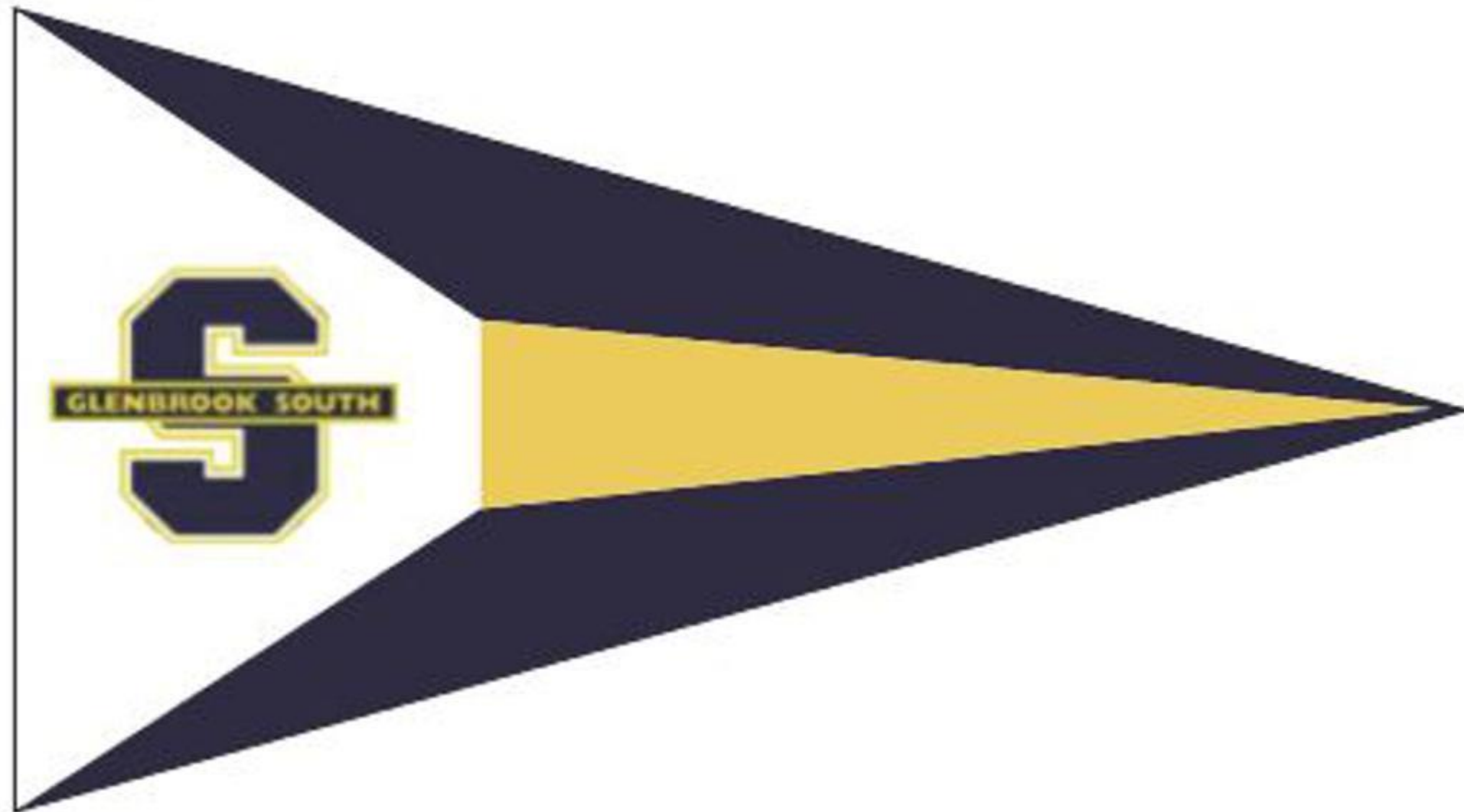

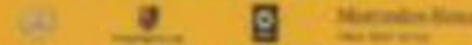
