Meeting Agenda:

New Clubs: NV Celtic was unanimously voted to become a club starting tonight. Votes were cast for Sierra Nevada FC, 11 No, 1 abstain and 3 yes. There were not enough votes to make them a club.

New Security Measure for Recreational: There were two incidents at Moana, possible child abduction and a sex offender that was at the field. Parents were made aware of the situation and were asked to be more vigilant on keeping their children safe.

New Policies: Play Up and Down:

Article 4 "Transfer of Players from One Team to Another.

- C. The GBYSL transfer window will only apply to U10-U15(8th graders) competitive players. Transfers of U15(9th graders)-U19 competitive players will not be recognized by GBYSL, and those players will not be eligible for League play.

The above policy was discussed and a change was made after a vote. The sentence "Transfers of U15(9th graders)-U19 competitive players will not be recognized by GBYSL, and those players will not be eligible for League play." was deleted.

High School Policy: no sit outs penalty.

ODP: Tryouts are on July 21-22 and August 18-19. Coaches are paid position. GBYSL will front the money and will be reimbursed once the fees are collected from players.

State Cup: NV United 01 Girls and Sierra NV 01 Boys were both finalist and will represent GBYSL to the President's Cup in Utah.

State AGM: June 4th at the Atlantis Casino.

GBYSL AGM: June 7th at the Hilton Garden Inn at 6 pm. The offices that are up for election are: VP-Competitive, VP-Recreational and Treasurer. If you want to run for the above offices, you have 14 days before the AGM to notify GBYSL office.

Try-out dates: June 18 through the 28th. You can start giving offers to players on June 29 at 6 pm. The order of tryouts is the following: NV United, CFC, Players, NV Celtic, Truckee River United and Spanish Springs Club. Independent teams will have their tryout on Sunday, June 24th.

Reports:

Marjorie: TOP Soccer has 17 players. There is an increase of participants in the buddy system. We are going to participate in the Autism Walk. Theresa Grillo and I will attend the symposium at Utah in May. I'm hoping to expand this program in Gardnerville by next year.

Richard: TMCC soccer field will break ground on July 2019 and will be used by men and women's league. WE are still working on Pembroke and Mill Street fields.

Maria: The general account has a balance of \$208,263.10 and the field account has \$117,995.24.
