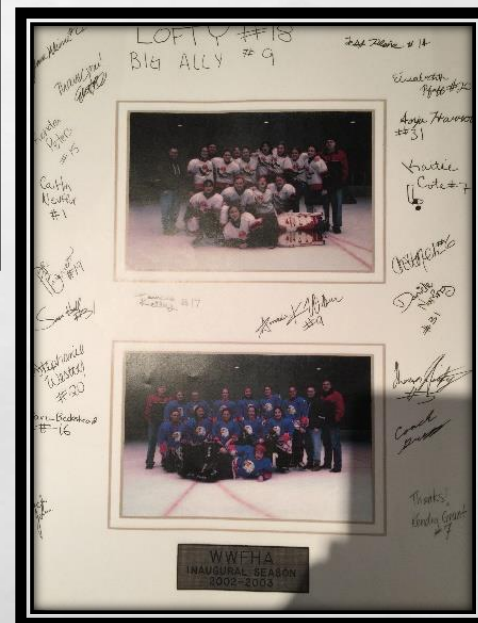


- 15TH ANNIVERSARY YEAR

 - SPECIAL PROGRAMS/COACH/ASSOCIATION EXPENSES



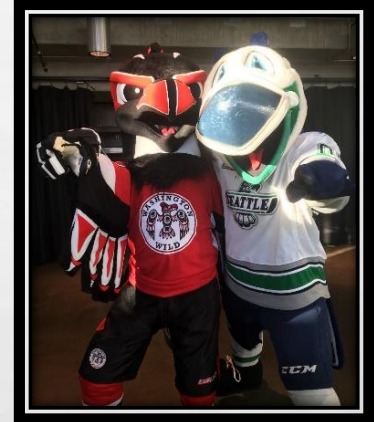

HIGHLIGHTS FROM WWFHL

- **12U/14U RED & WHITE**

- THE 12U/14U AGE DIVISION GREW BY LEAPS AND BOUNDS THIS SEASON. WHILE THE SEASON STARTED WITH A HEALTHY SIXTEEN PLAYERS, THE RANKS SWELLED AS THE NEXT COUPLE OF MONTHS BROUGHT IN SEVERAL MORE DETERMINED HOCKEY PLAYERS. THE TWO TEAMS, TEAM RED AND TEAM WHITE, MET EACH WEEK TO PUT THEIR PRACTICE SKILLS TO THE TEST AND FOR COMPETITION. EACH TEAM CHALLENGED THE OTHER IN SOME WAY AS INDICATED BY TIGHT GAME SCORES.
- TEAM WHITE TOOK THE WWFHL 1ST PLACE RIBBON AND TEAM RED NABBED SECOND PLACE.

HIGHLIGHTS FROM WWFHL

• 10U RED, WHITE & GREY

- THE THREE TEAMS COMPRISING THE 10U AGE DIVISION THIS SEASON WORKED HARD AGAINST EACH OTHER IN A THREE TEAM/TWO GAME FORMAT WHERE ONE TEAM PLAYED TWO GAMES EACH WEEK.
- 10U TEAM GREY CAME IN FIRST IN THE STANDINGS WITH 23 POINTS, 10U TEAM WHITE FOLLOWED WITH 19 POINTS - JUST EDGING OUT 10U TEAM RED WHO FINISHED WITH 18 POINTS.
- TEAM WHITE COLLECTED THE WWFHL THIRD PLACE RIBBON AND STAYED TO WATCH THE FINAL MATCHUP OF THE WEEKEND - THE SHOWDOWN FOR THE GOLD MEDAL: TEAM RED VS. TEAM GREY: WITH TEAM GREY AS THE INAUGURAL CHAMPIONS!

HIGHLIGHTS FROM WWFHL

• 8U RED & WHITE

- THE 8U AGE DIVISION DOESN'T KEEP SCORE; HOWEVER, THAT DIDN'T STOP THE PLAYERS IN THAT GROUP FROM WORKING HARD DURING EVERY GAME. EACH PLAYER ALSO EXPERIENCED PLAYING IN NET AS A GOALIE
- THE 8U CHAMPIONSHIP GAME WAS SELECTED AS ONE OF THE INTERNATIONAL ICE HOCKEY FEDERATION (IIHF) 2018 GLOBAL GIRLS GAMES. AFTER THEIR HOUR MATCH UP, ALL THE GIRLS RECEIVED CERTIFICATES AND BEADED NECKLACES TO CELEBRATE.
